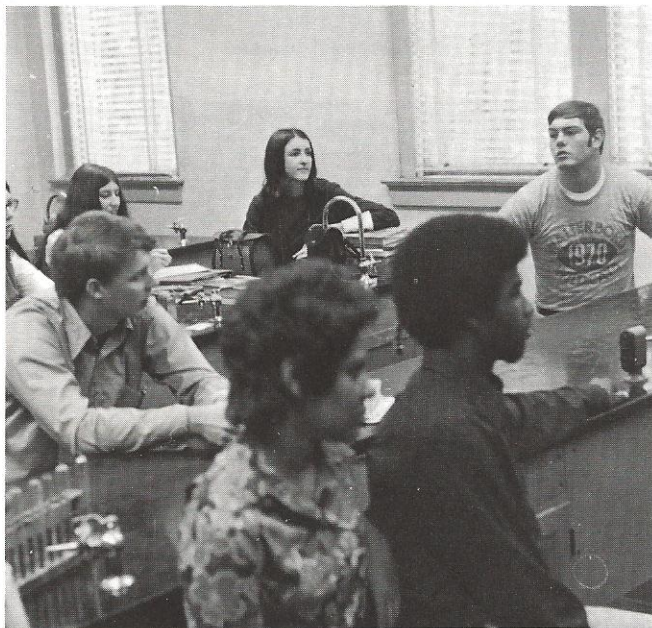


Future Scientists Follow Special Interests
