The web of life grew more complex and entangling, We searched for a way to enrich and simplify this web with our advancing knowledge.


We knew the world would become ours, ours to improve or to destroy.




#### Band Adds Music and Pep to School Activities







The improvement shown over the season and a victory in their last game paves the way for next season as 25 lettermen will be returning.







Each member has contributed to the team by always doing his best — whether at practice or in a game. Thie hard work has paid off by making this season one to remember.


