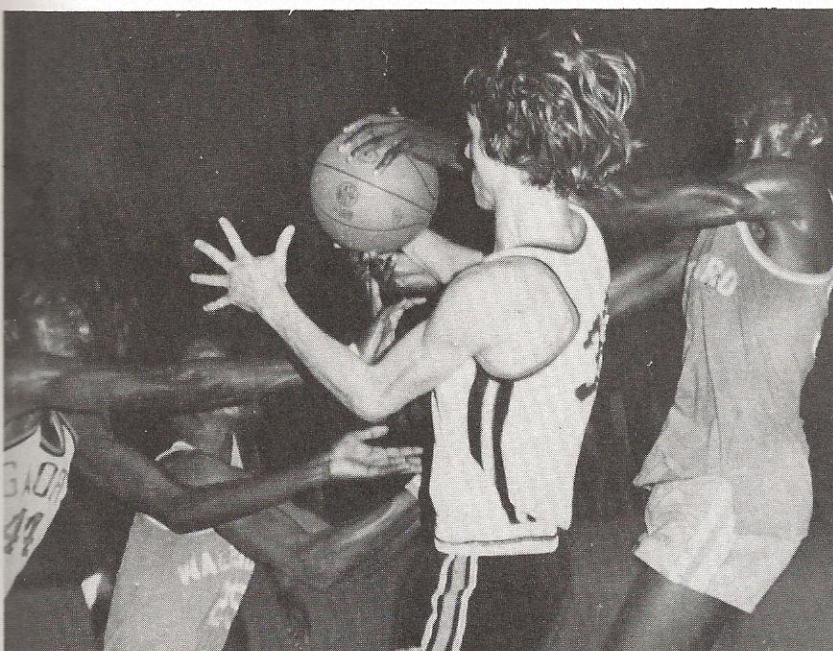
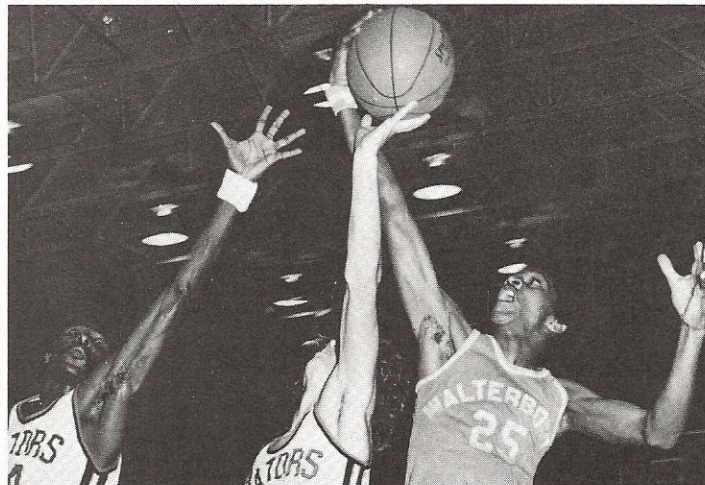
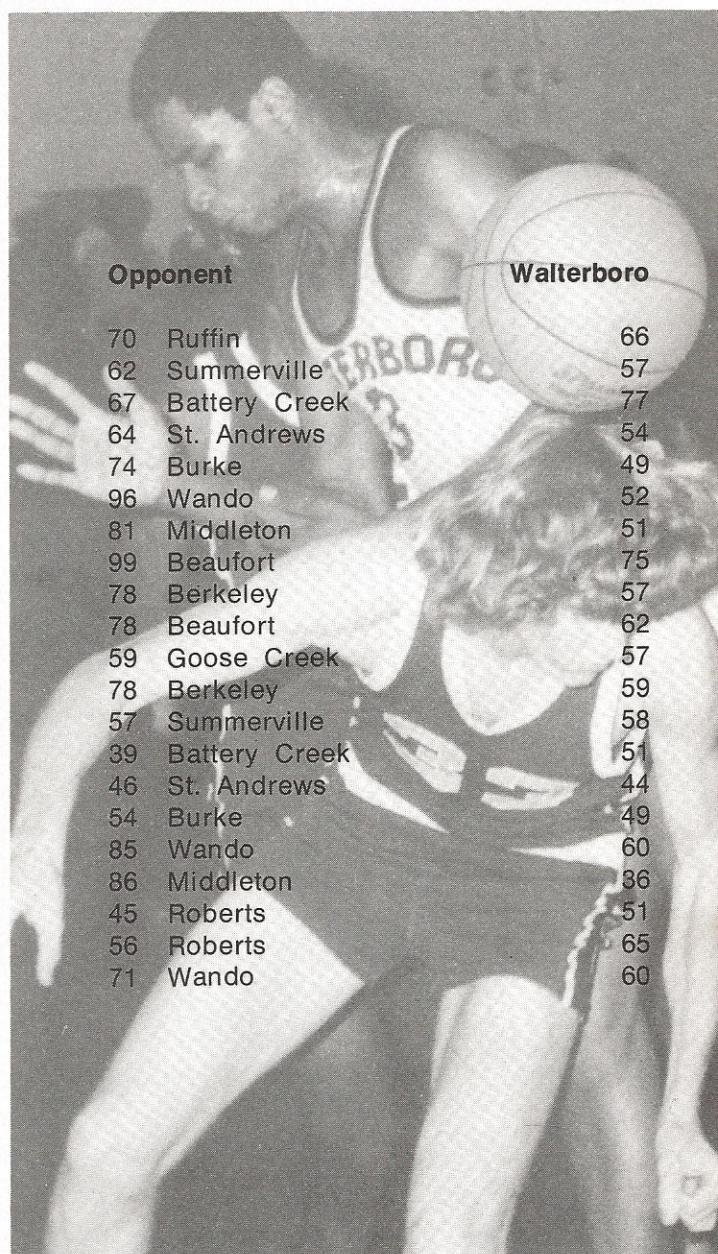


# Hussle and Determination Mark Young Varsity
