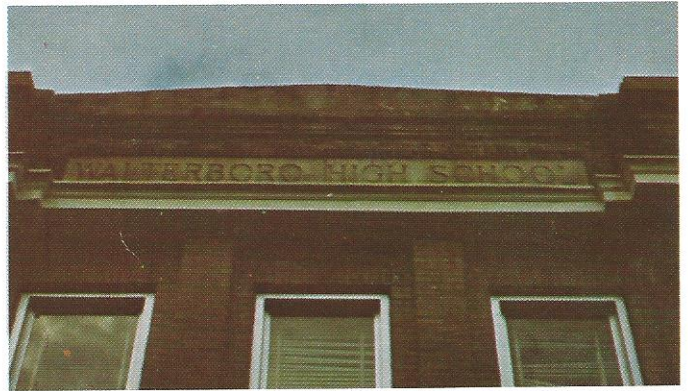

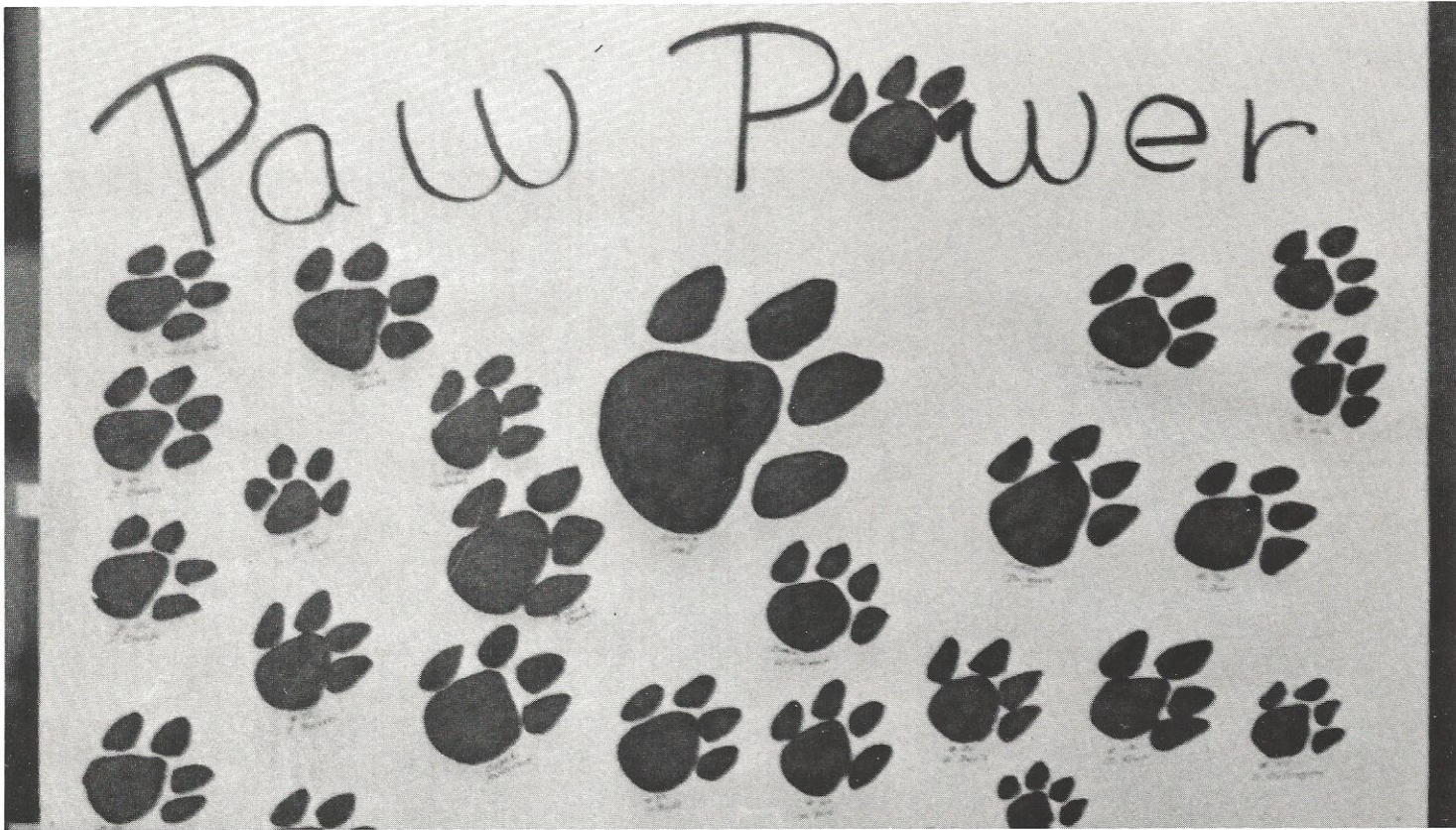

Finally, we give a cheer to the graduating class of 1980. Success and happiness in the days to come.

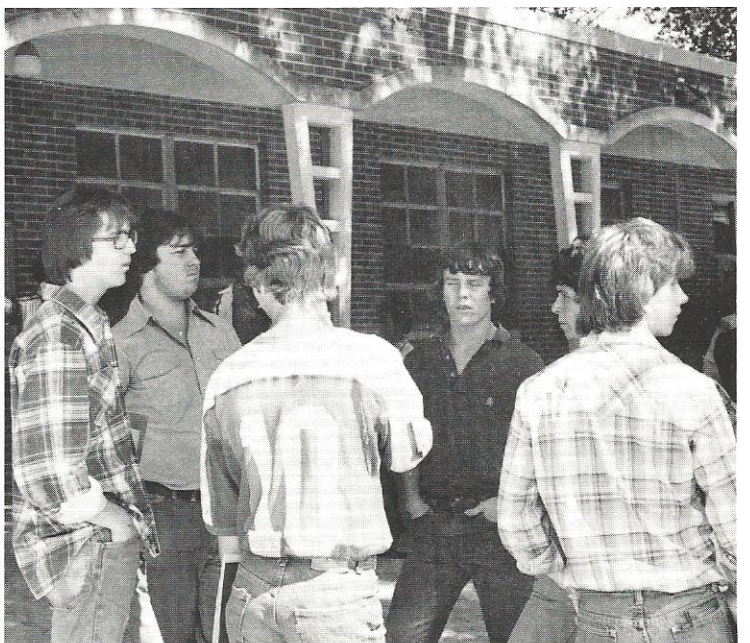
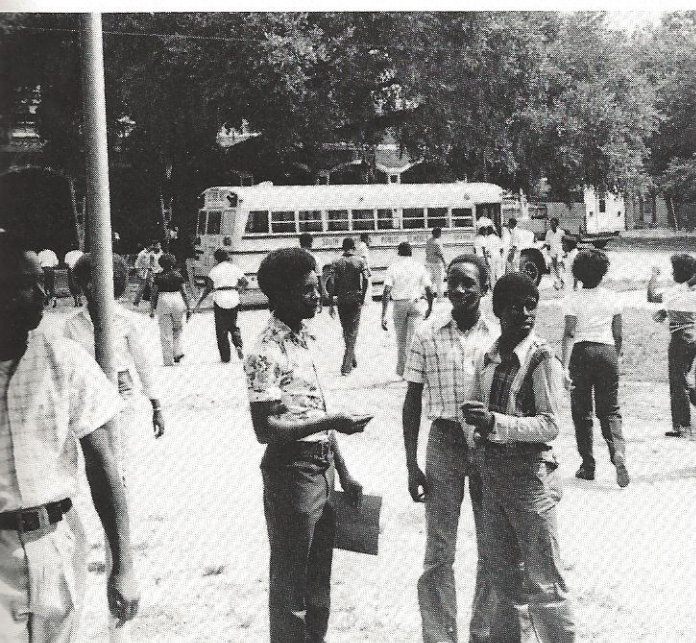
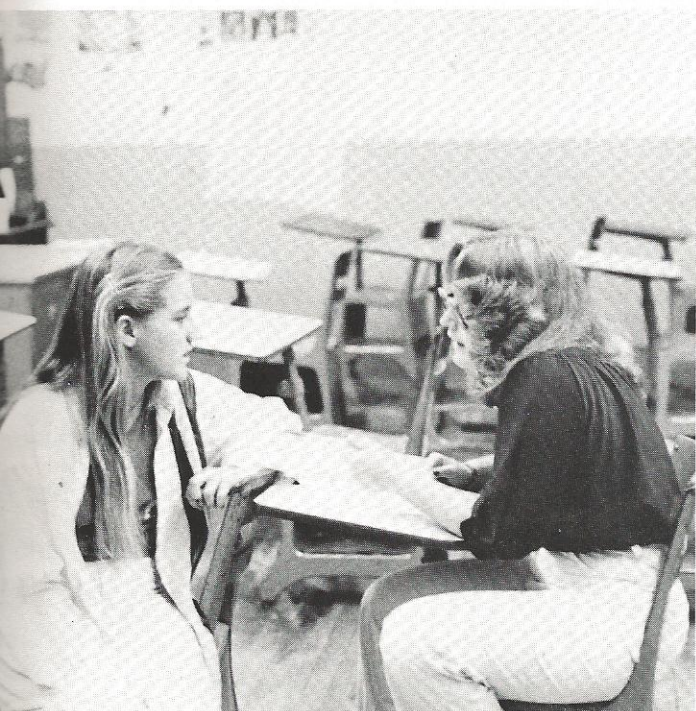

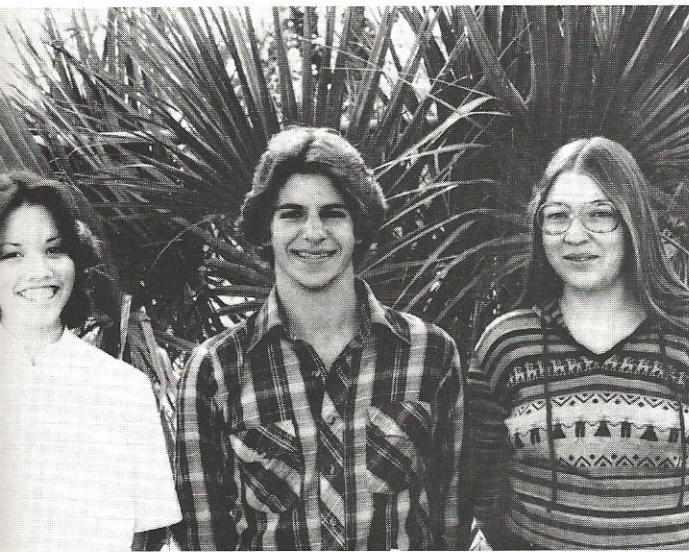

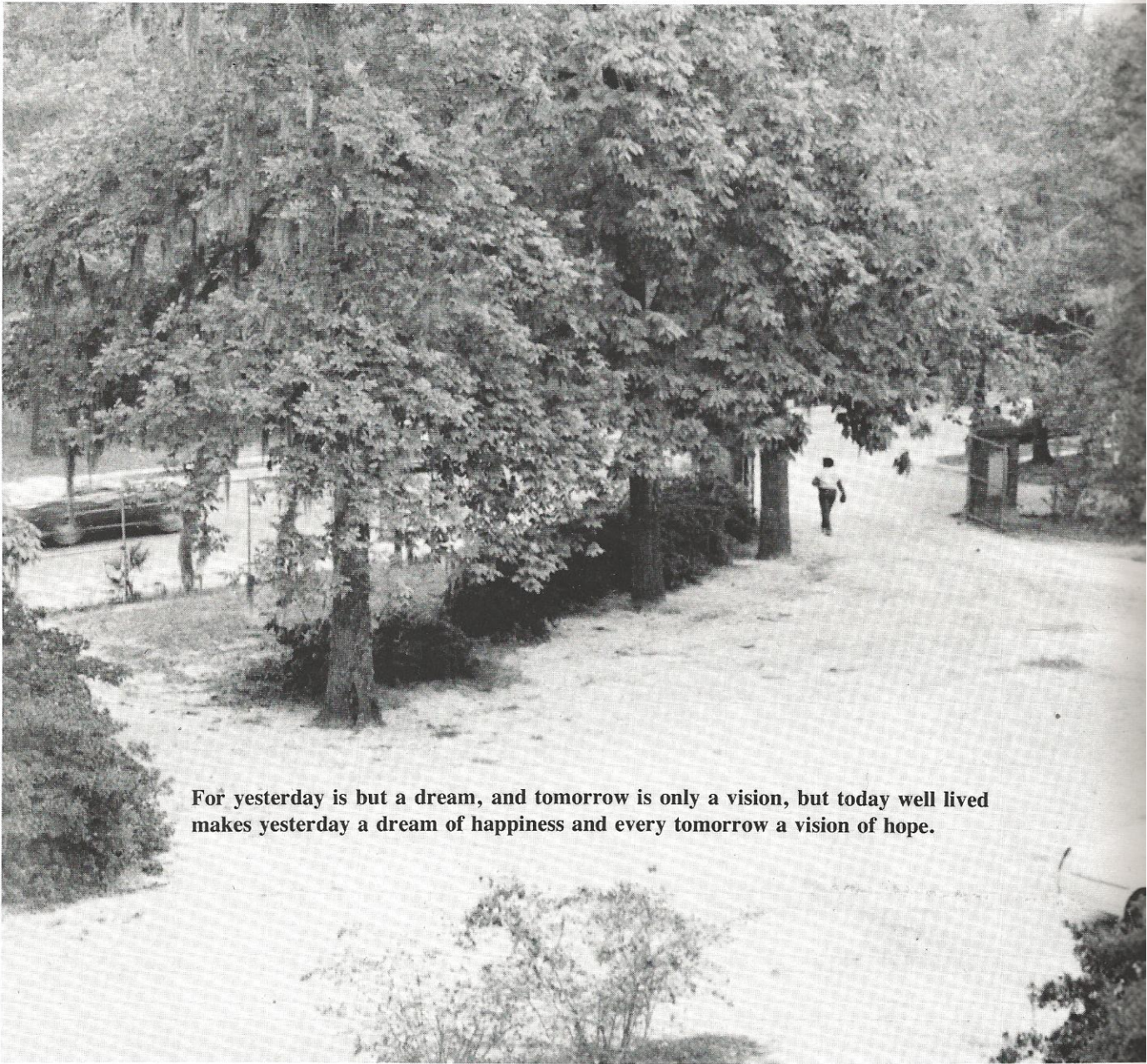
Looking back, the decade of the 1970's was one of great change for the nation as well as for our community.
