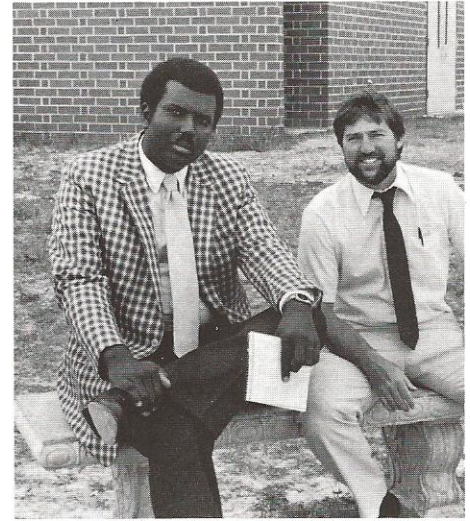
Principals and assistant principals alike helped maintain a uniform, standard of discipline.
