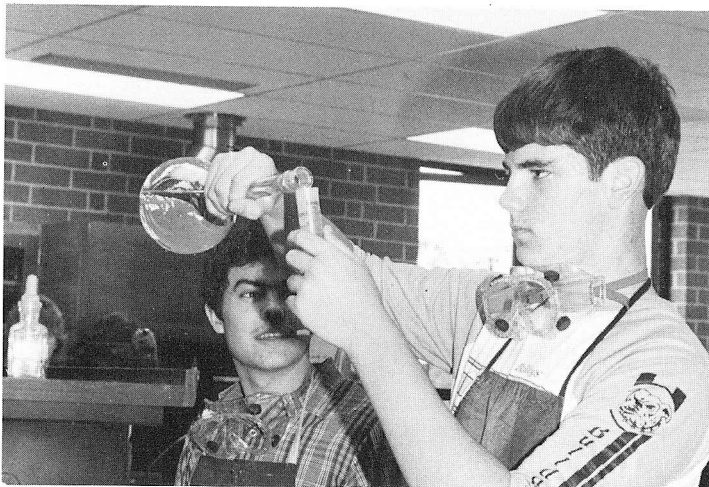
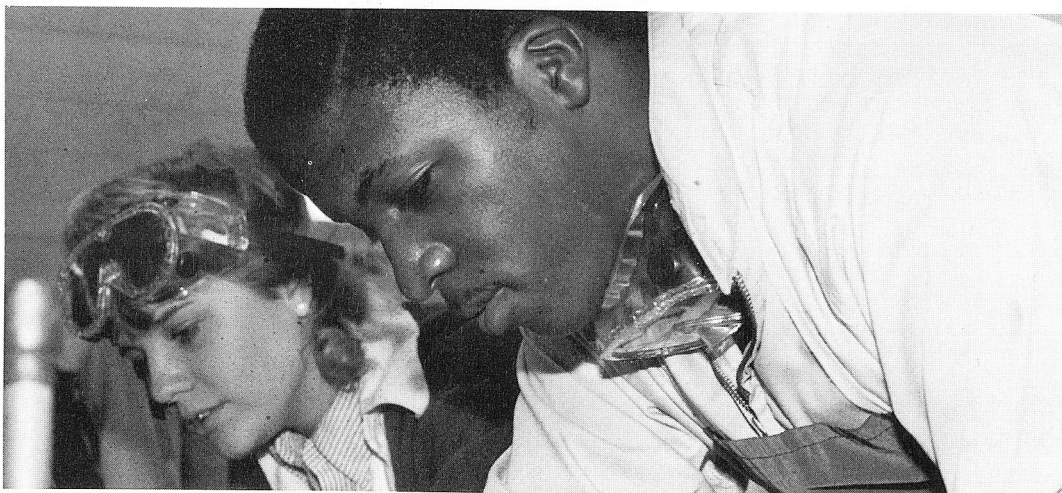
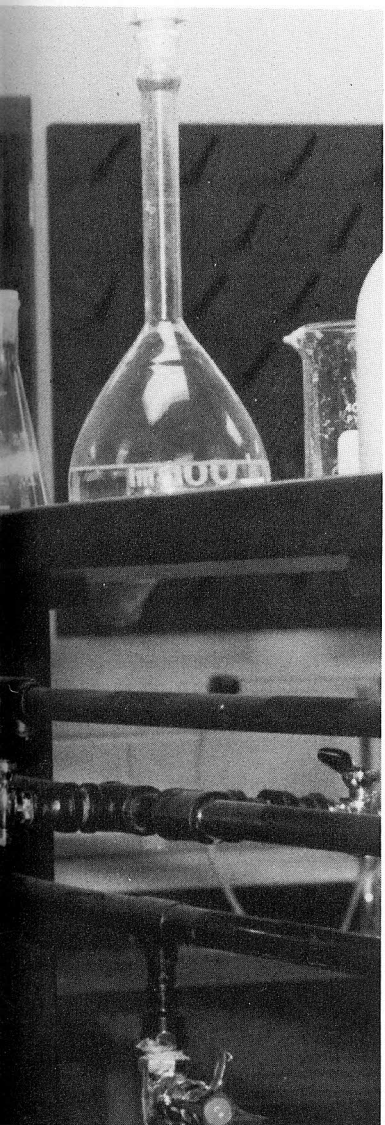




During her first taste of lab work, Pattie Hartnett adjusts her microscope to view a one-celled organism in Biology I.
