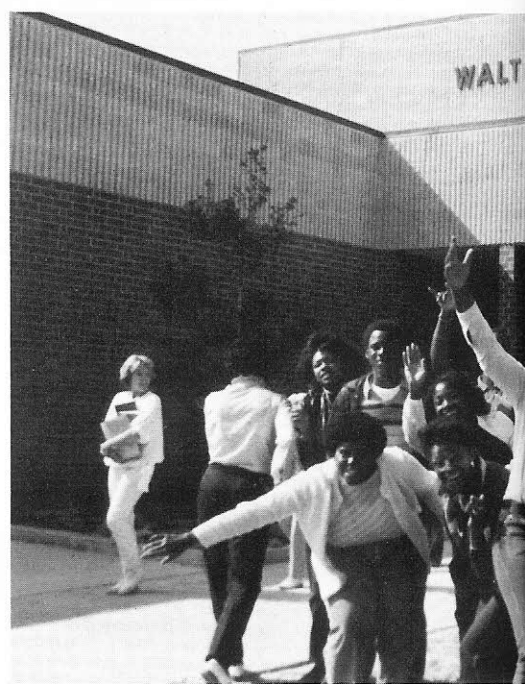
College, jobs, marriage, and kids, stood waiting for us.
