

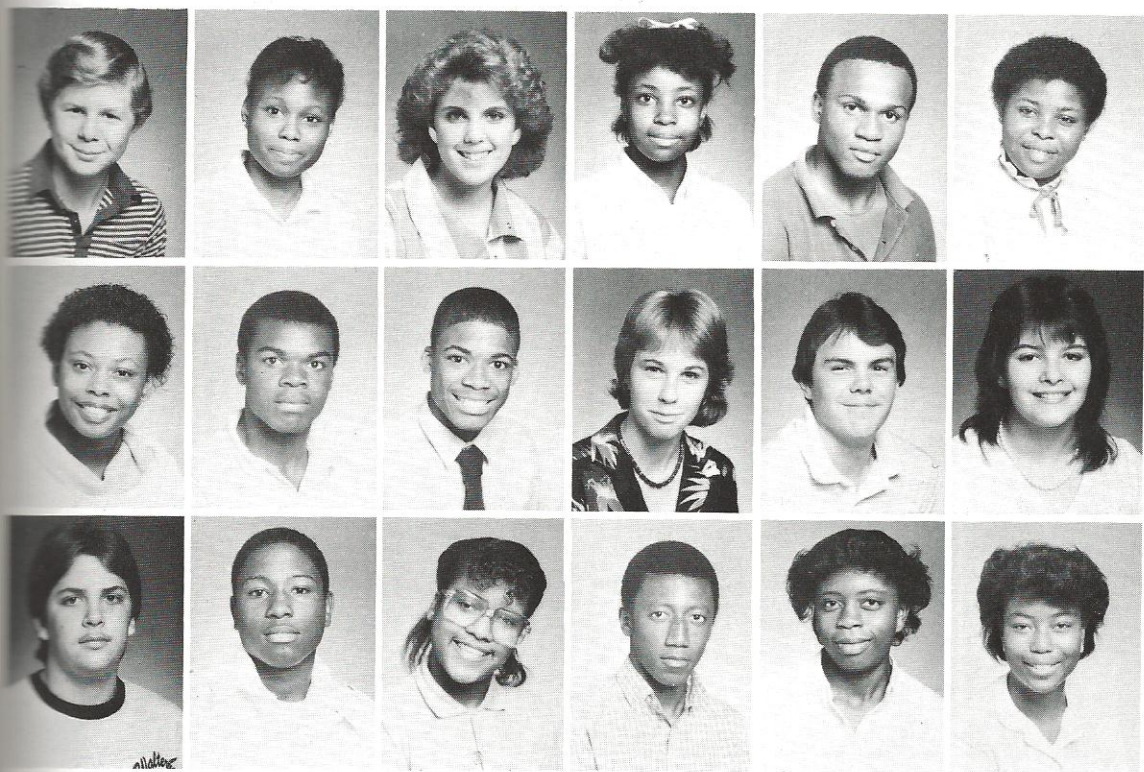
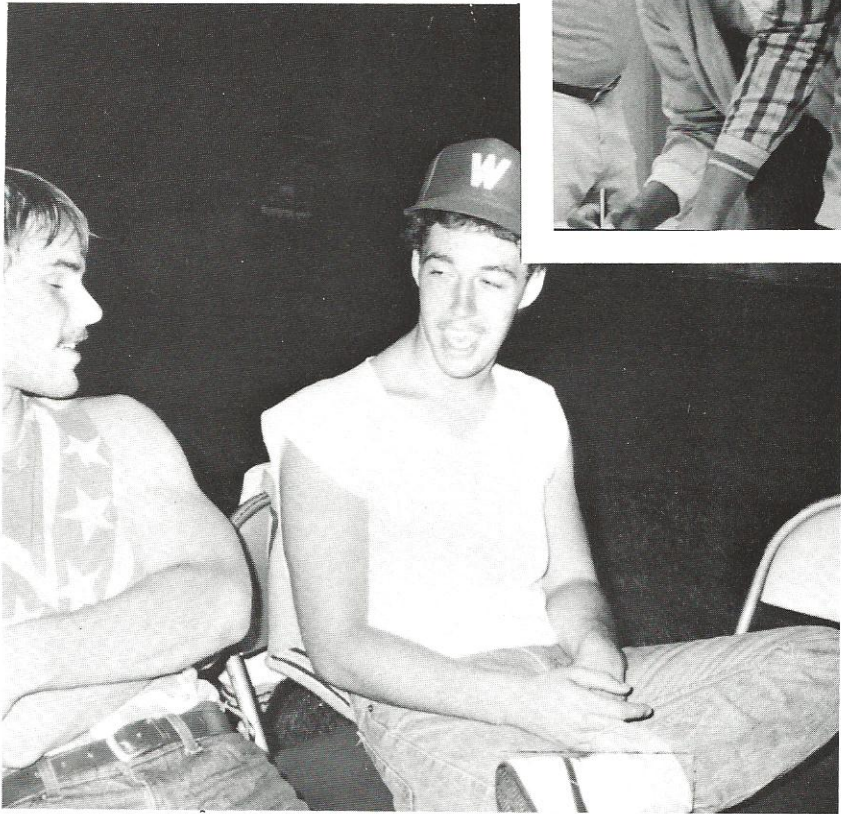
No Pain, No Gain
