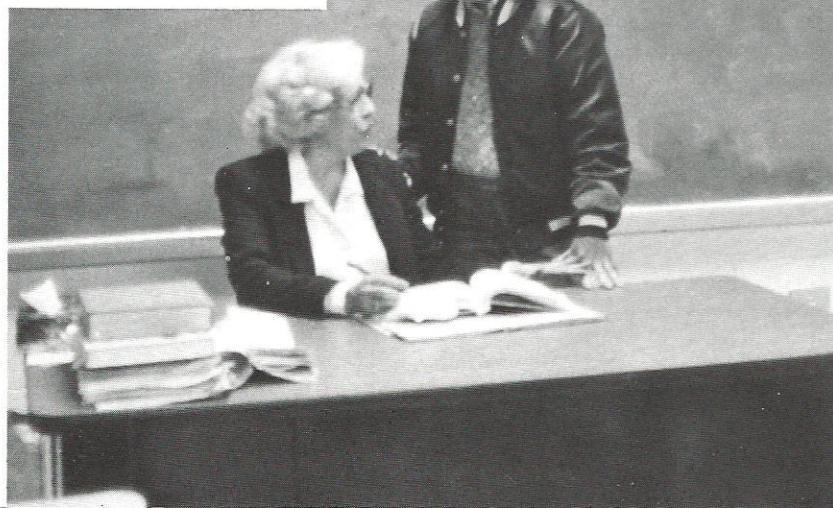




Liz Parrish finds it nice to have her mother explain a grammar rule to her.

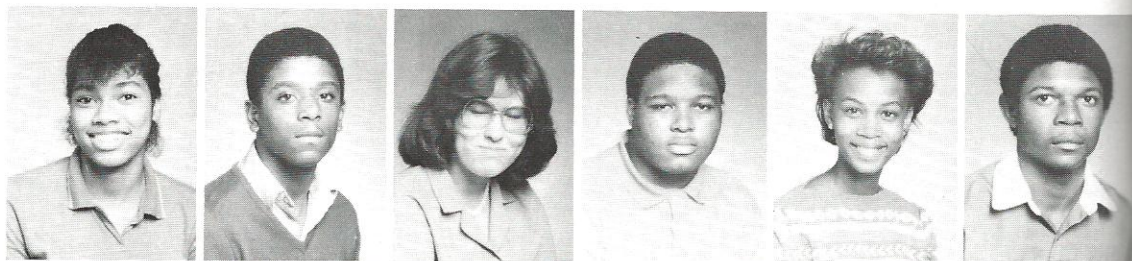


# Sign My Pass, Mom

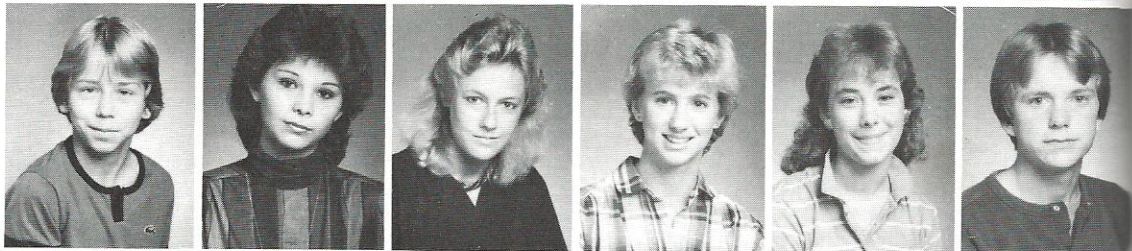
