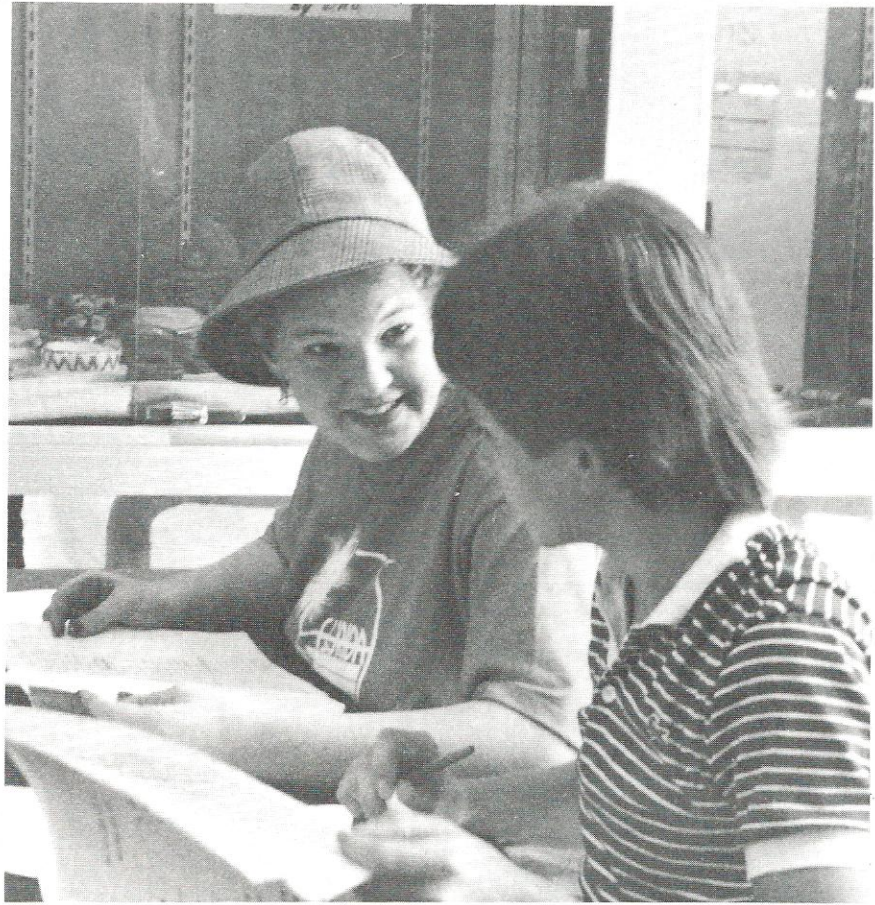
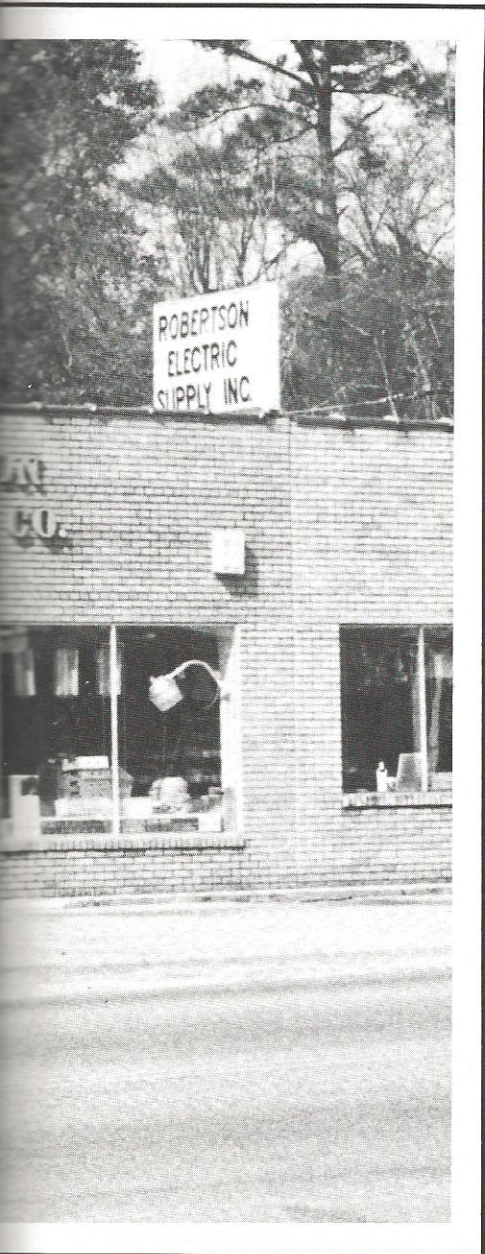

CASTING LOTS
