while she sits on the floor in her room. Maho is also a Varsity cheerleader.

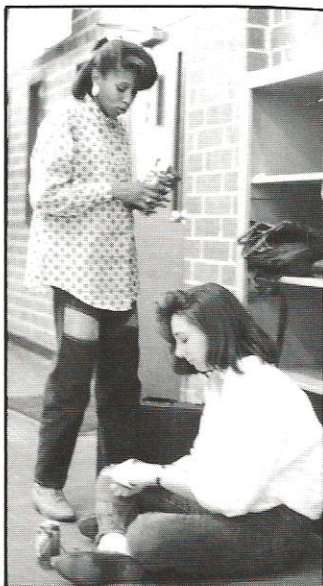

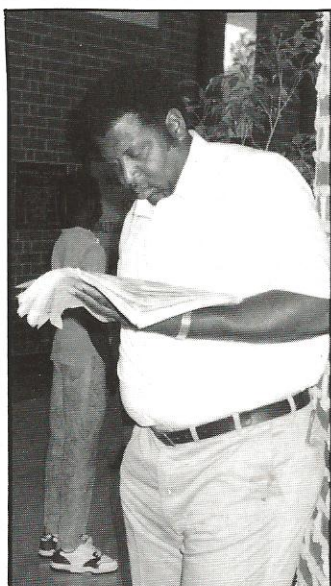
. . . The words in a book start coming off the page while I'm studying.
