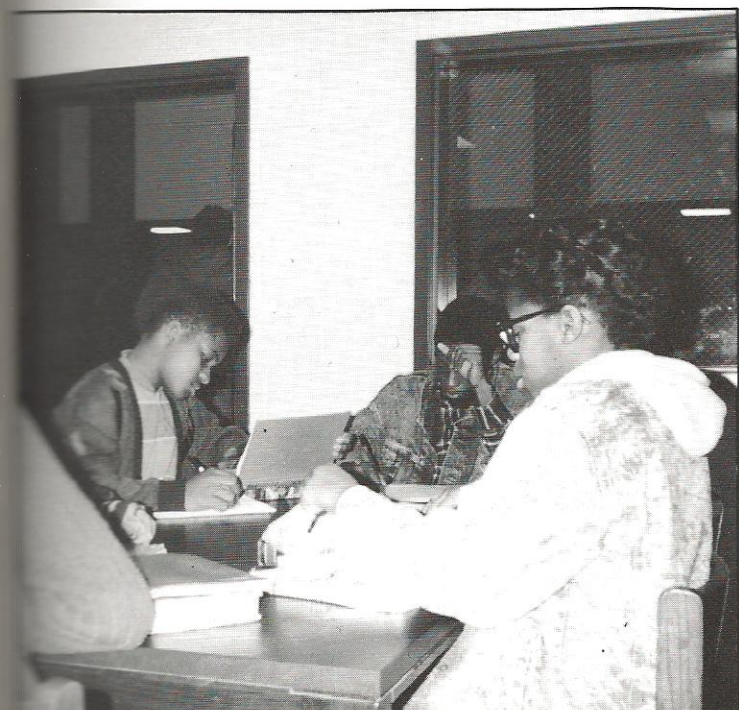
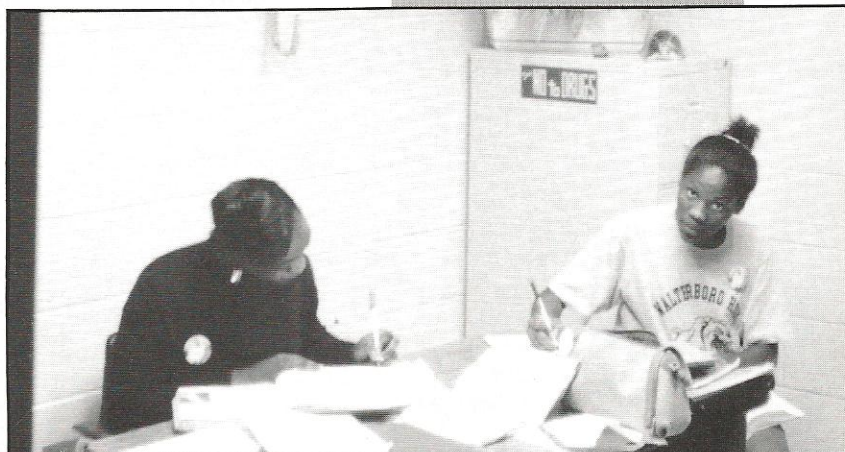


Printing a few helpful tips, senior An-
