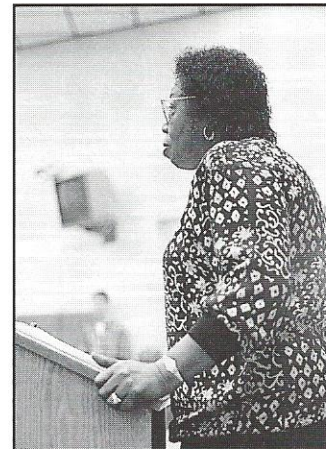
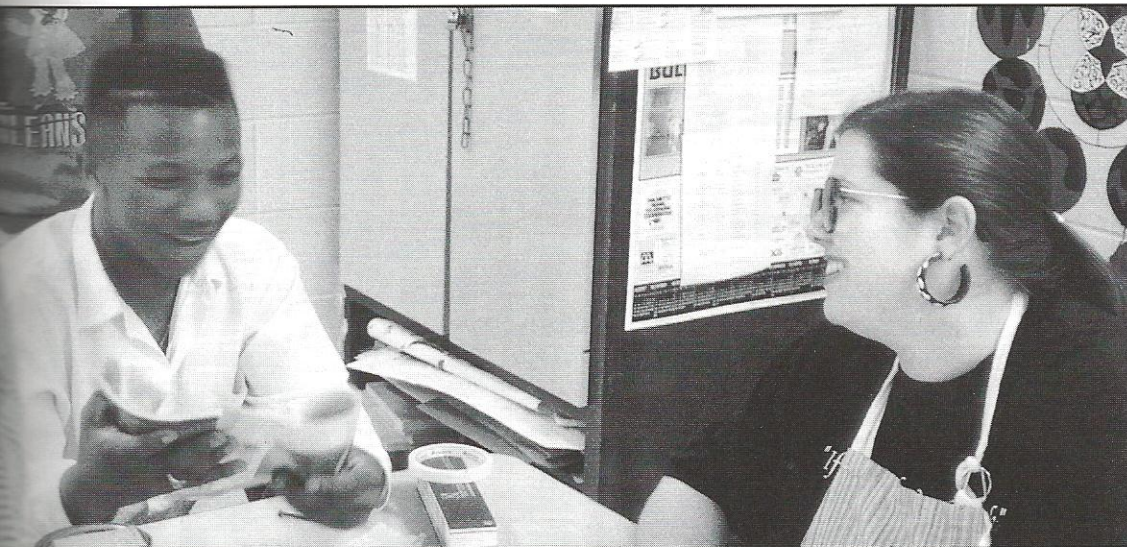
When a job was well done, students and clubs usually got most of the credit. However, behind each organization or individual usually was a supportive staff member guiding the way.
