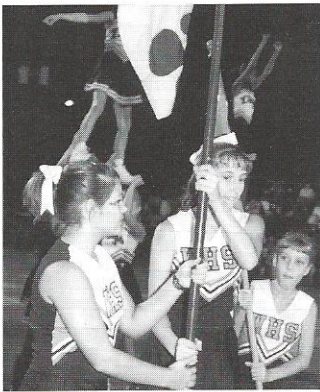
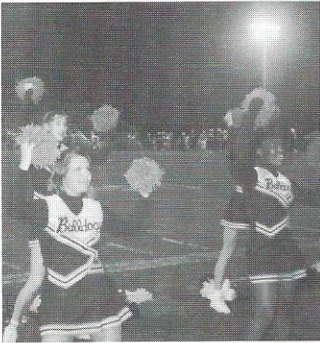
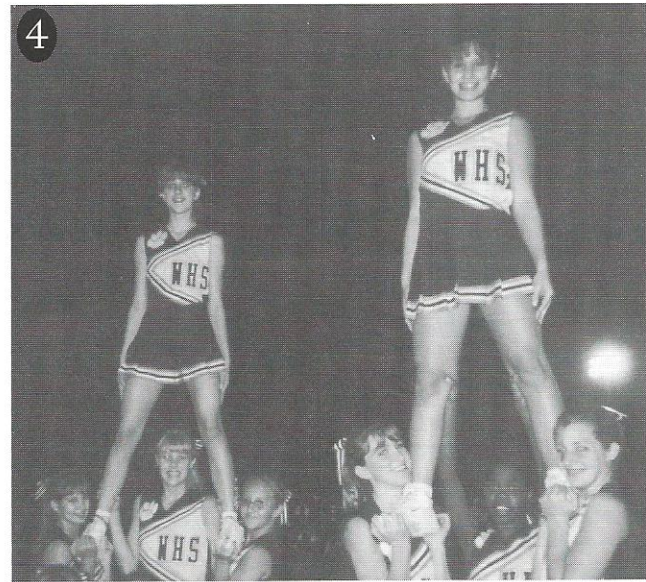
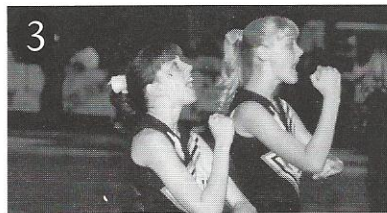


# J.V. Cheerleaders

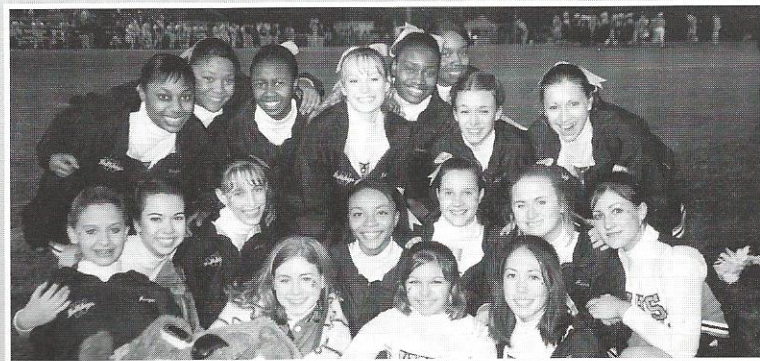
**We are the Best.** Screaming, cheering, stomping, and clapping, was the Varsity Cheerleaders' job at Friday night football games.



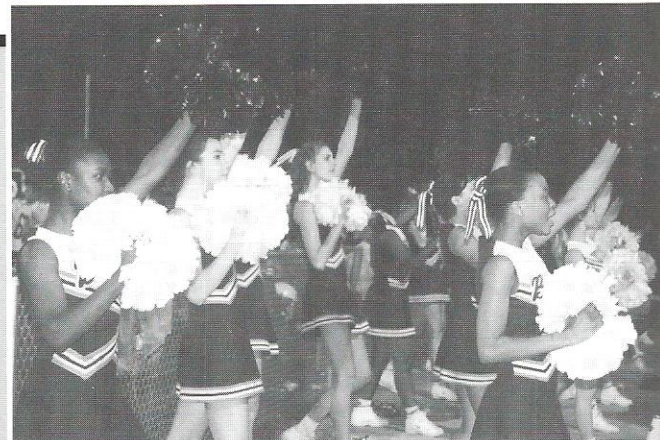
**Flying high.** Senior Jennifer Castles and sophomore Amanda Johnston run across the field holding the Bulldog's flag.
