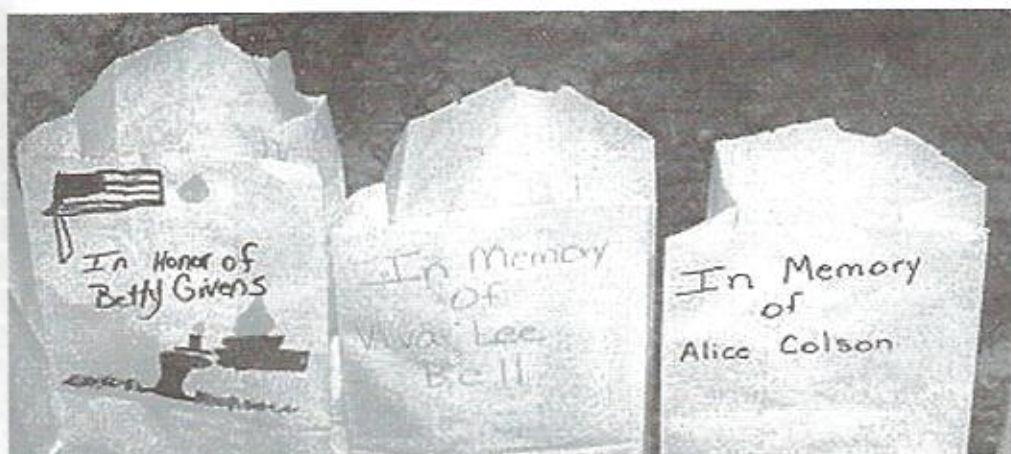


Racing for a Cure
