May Day 1991

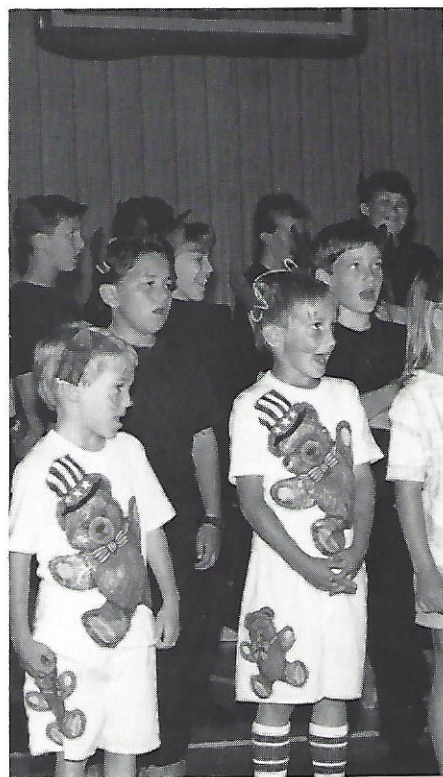
