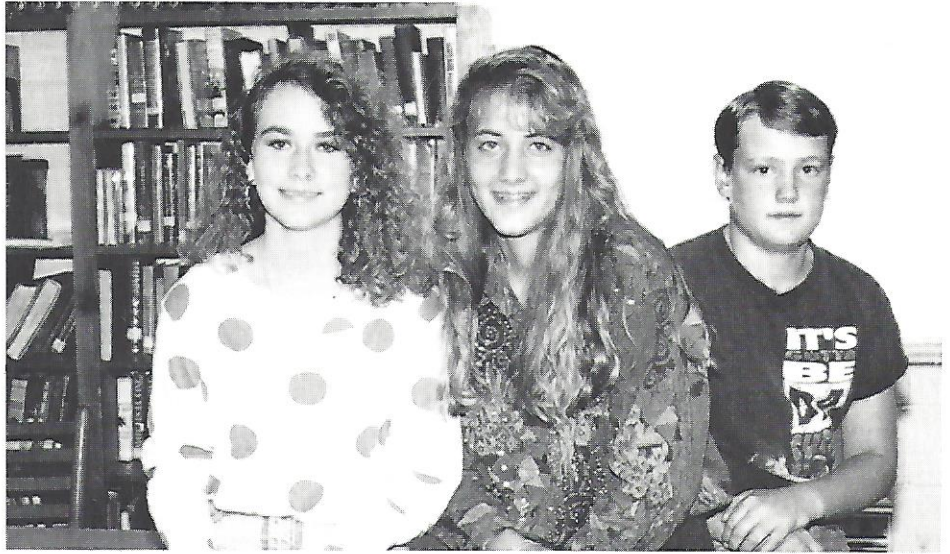
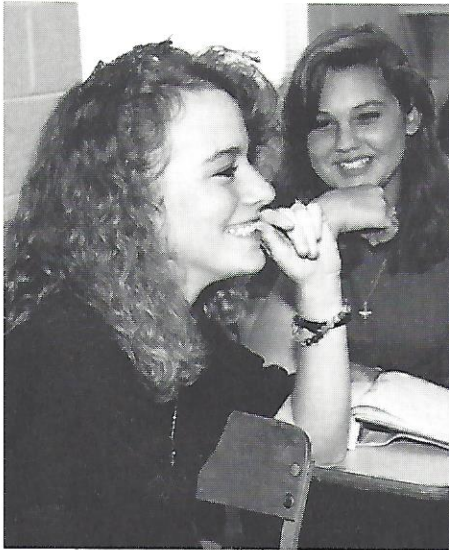


## Driver's License

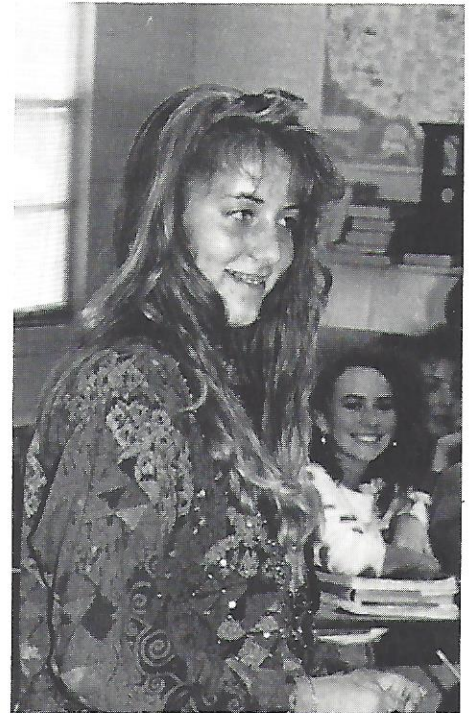
