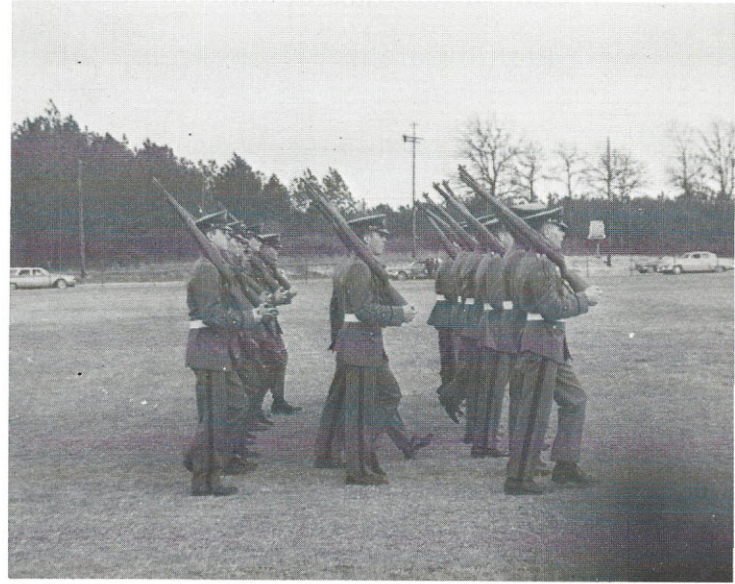

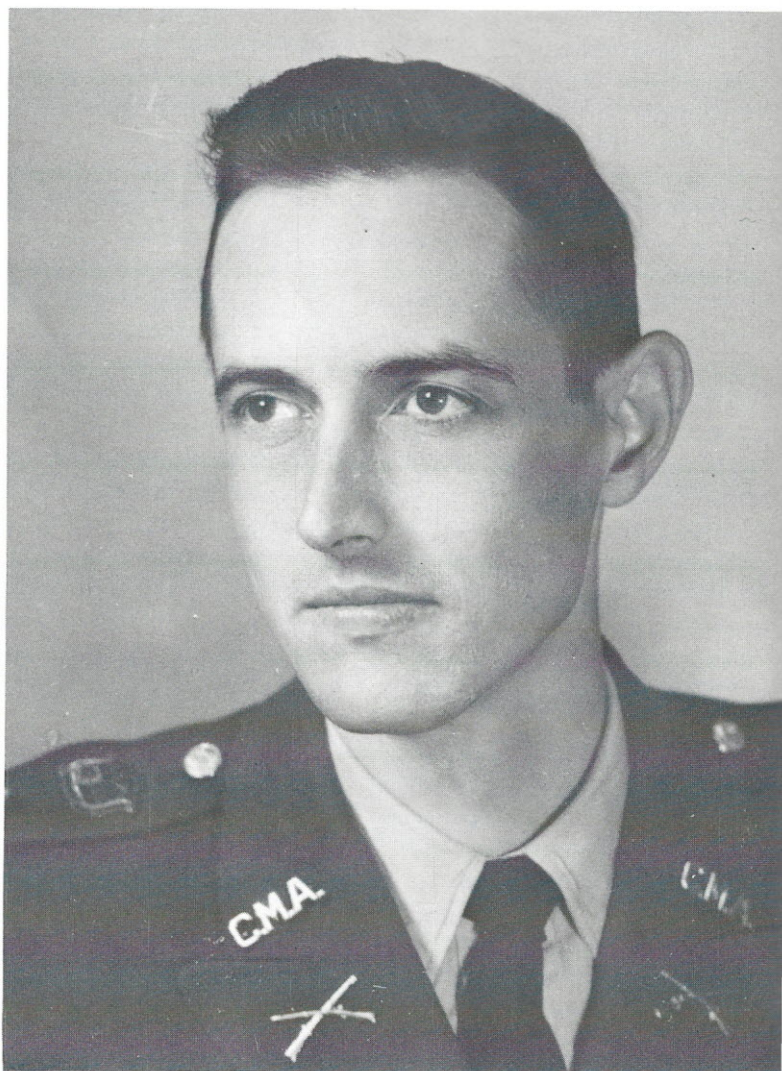
Col. James F. Risher

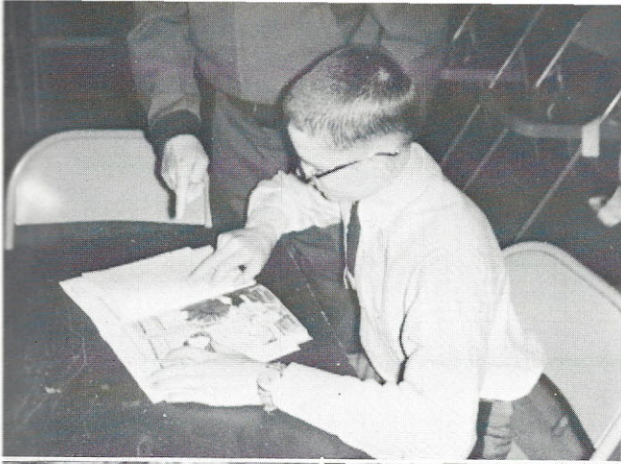
Col. Lanning P. Risher

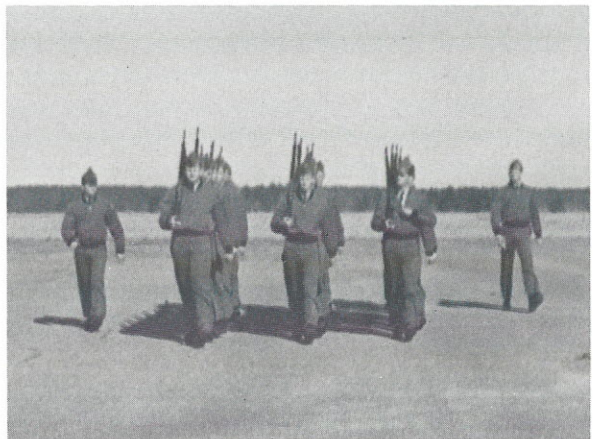
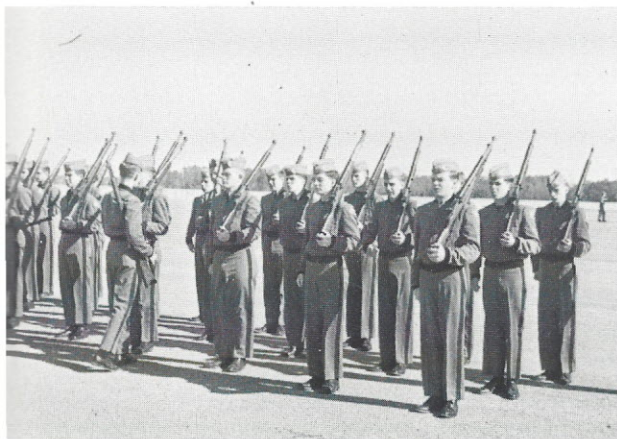
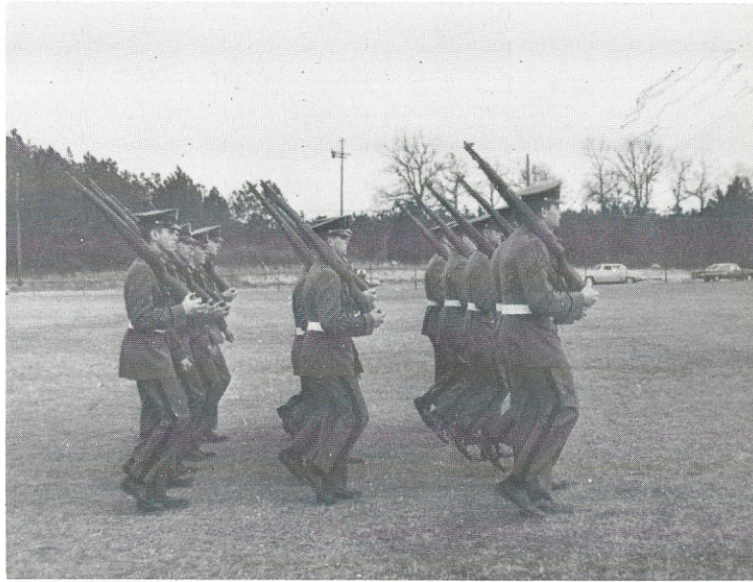


COMMISSIONED OFFICERS
