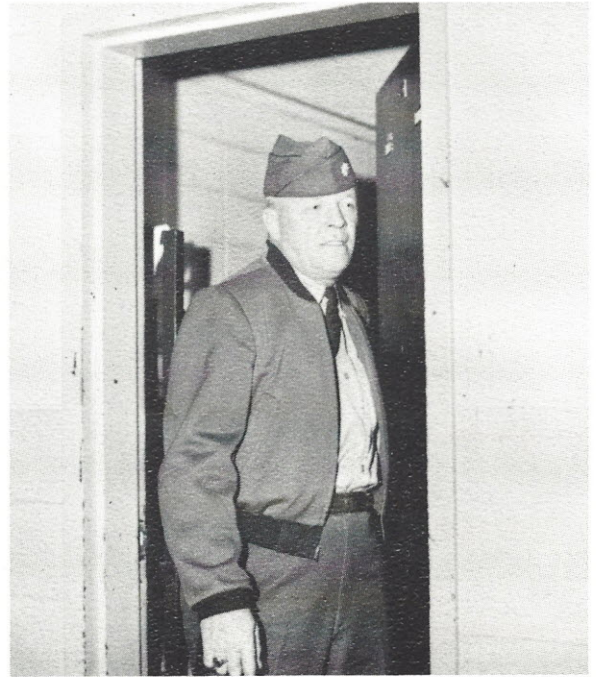
For the years you have been with the school we all know you as a kind and understanding person. In your daily ac-

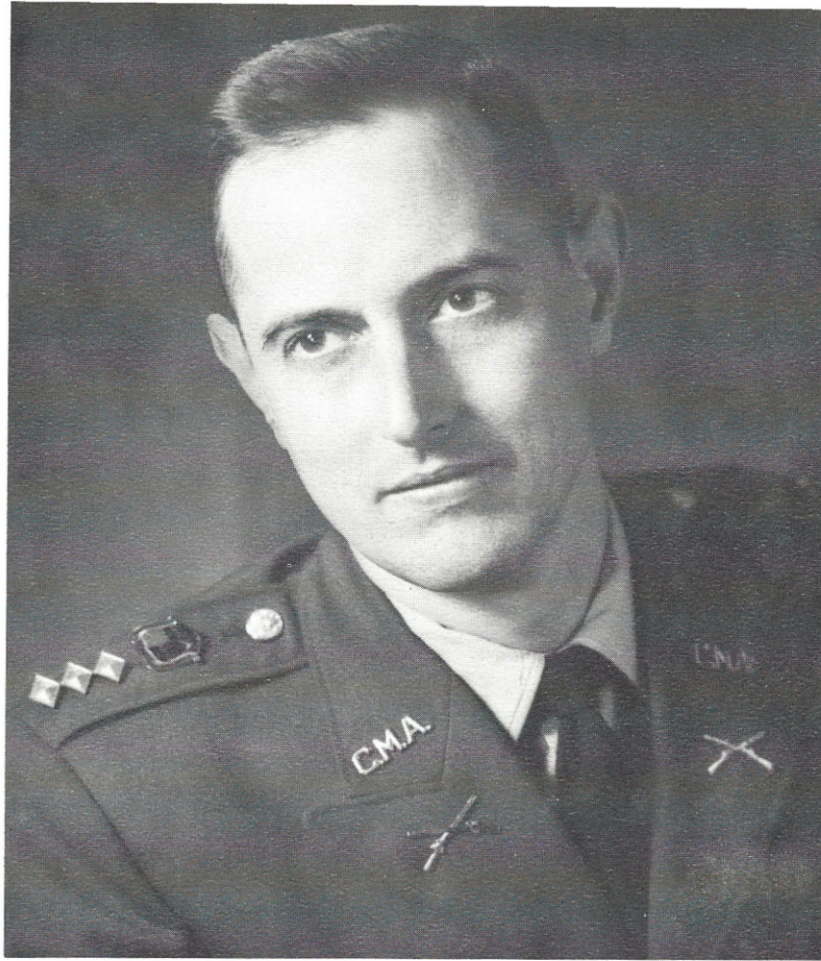
# THE PRESIDENT

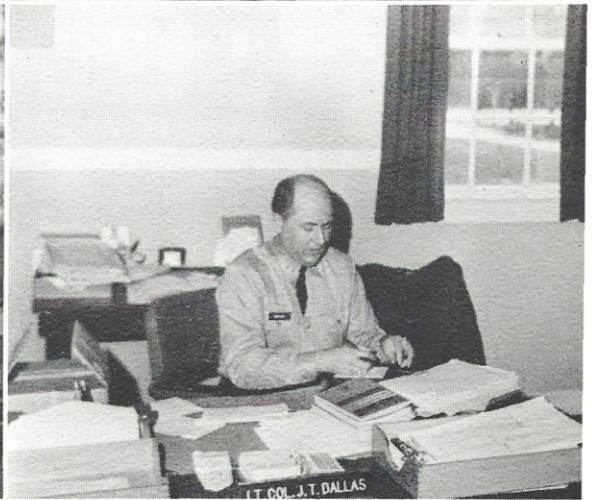
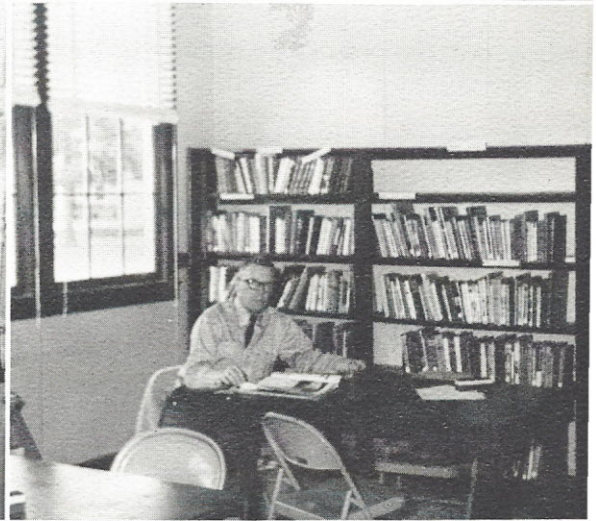


**LT. COL. JAMES T. DALLAS**
