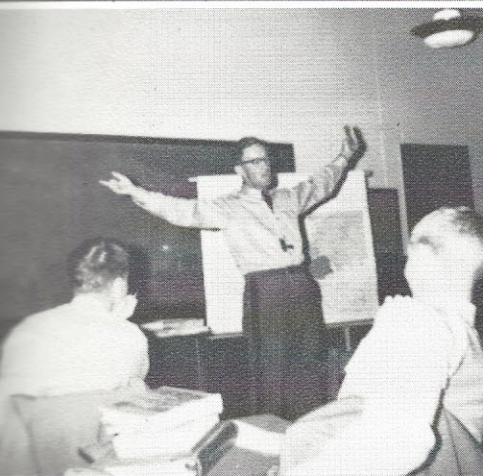
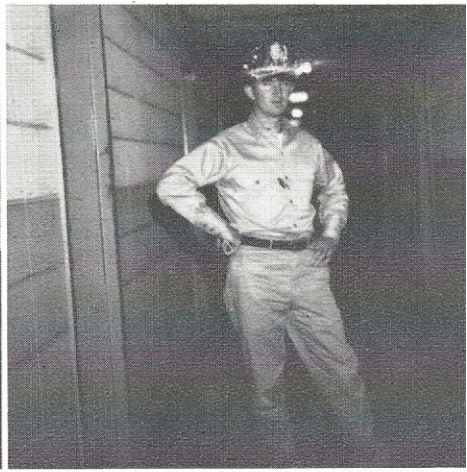

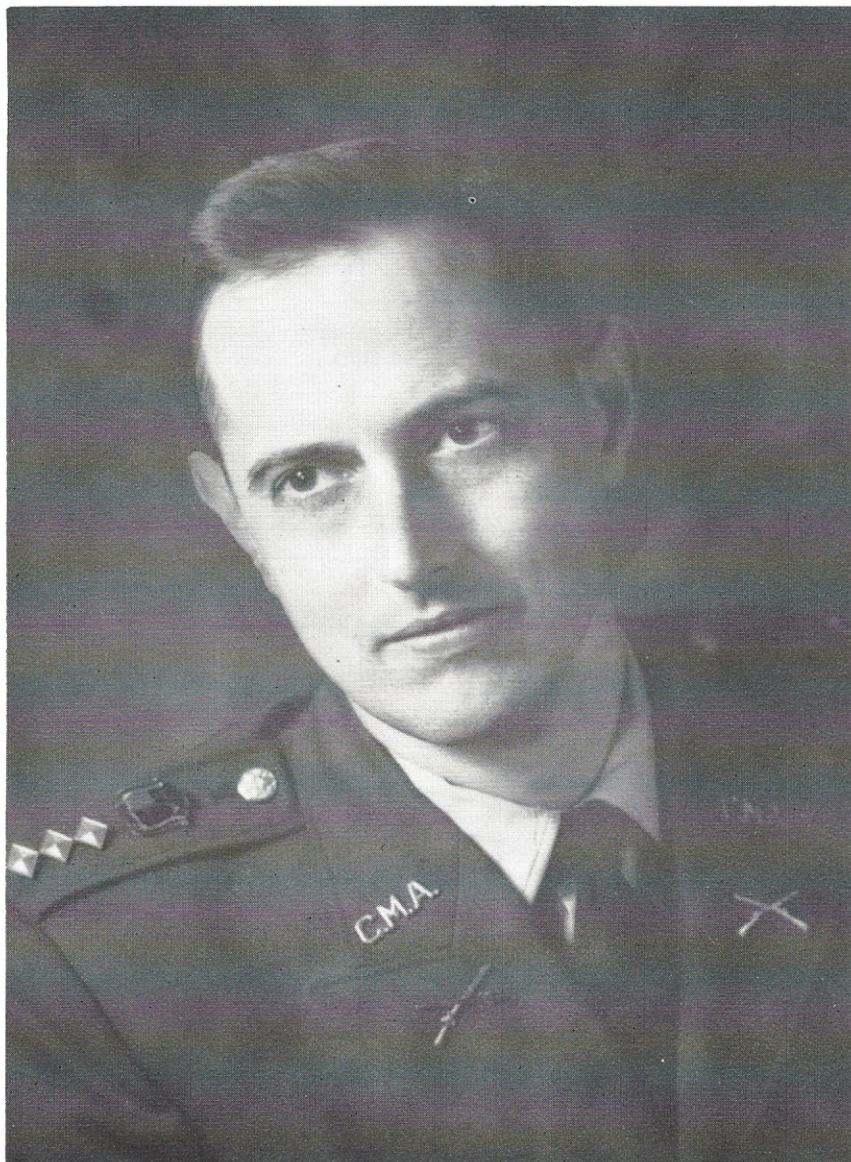
THE PRESIDENT

MAJOR WILLIAM P. BECKHAM

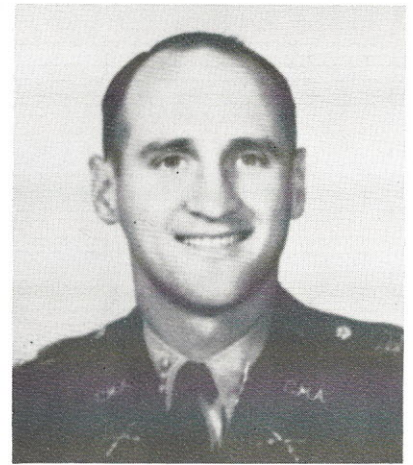

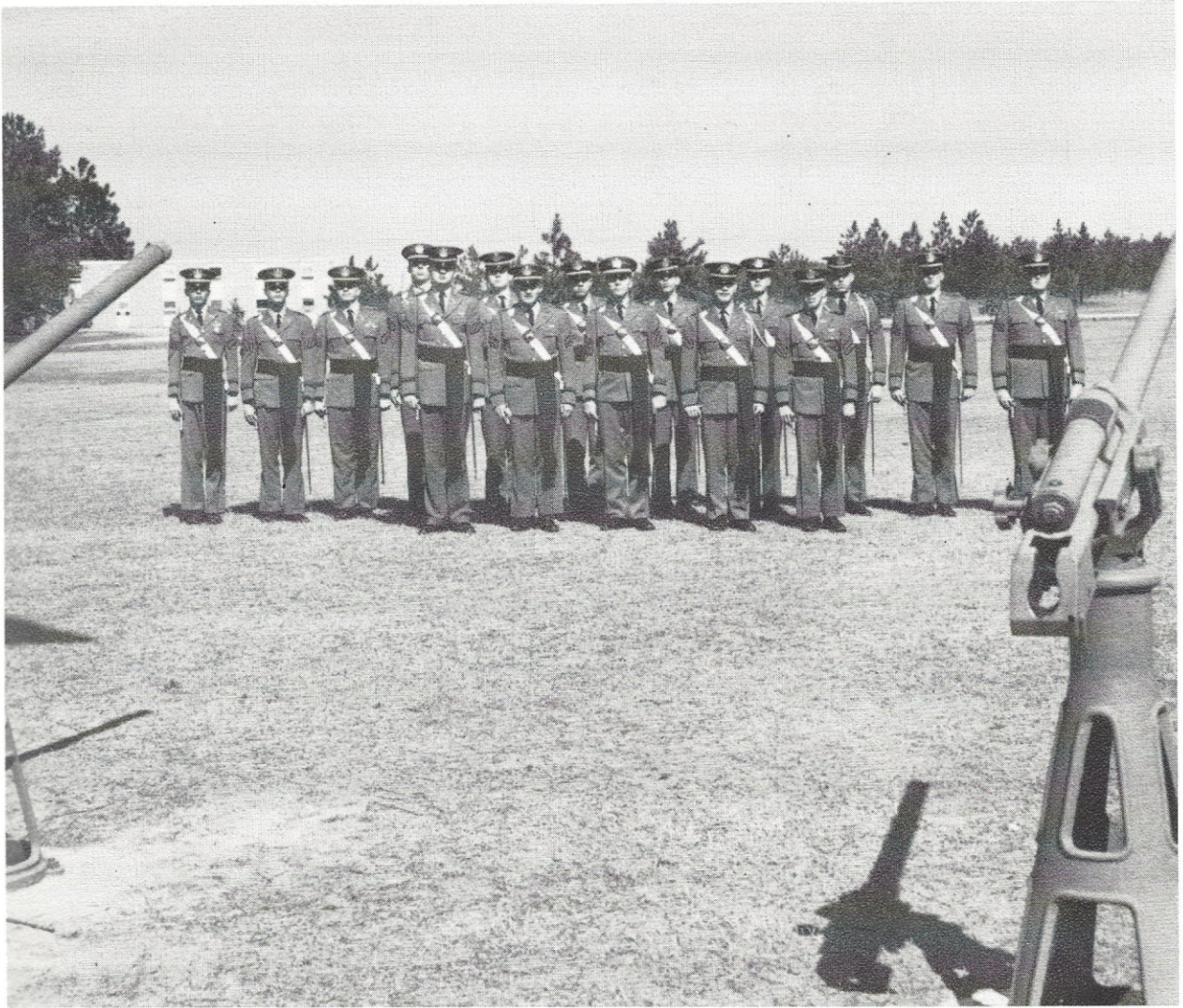
The training cadre not only trains the new boys to drill, but also gives advice concerning military courtesy. The cadre is always glad to help the new cadets in any way possible.

ability of these men depends the success of the corp of cadets. These men have been selected on the basis of their leadership abilities and merit.

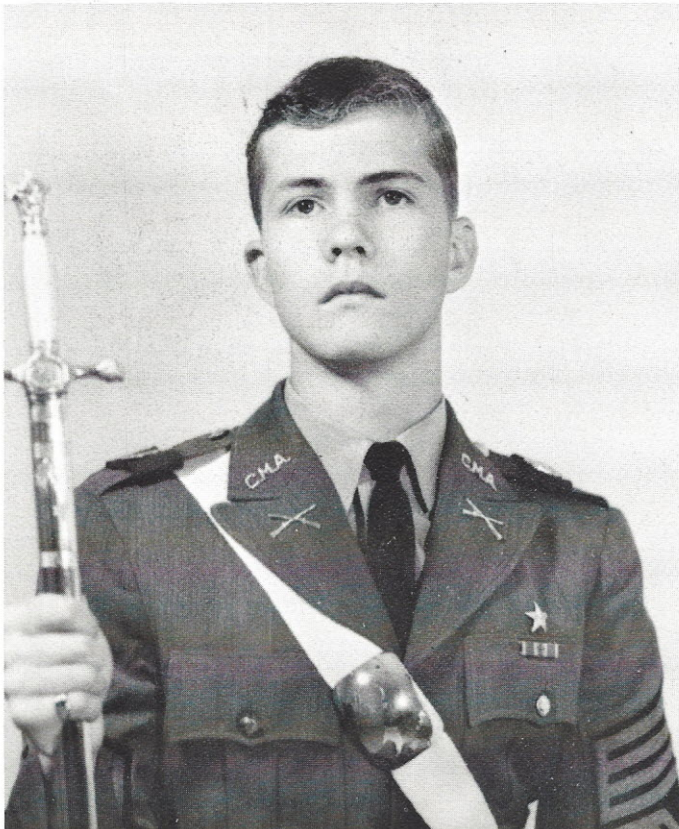
