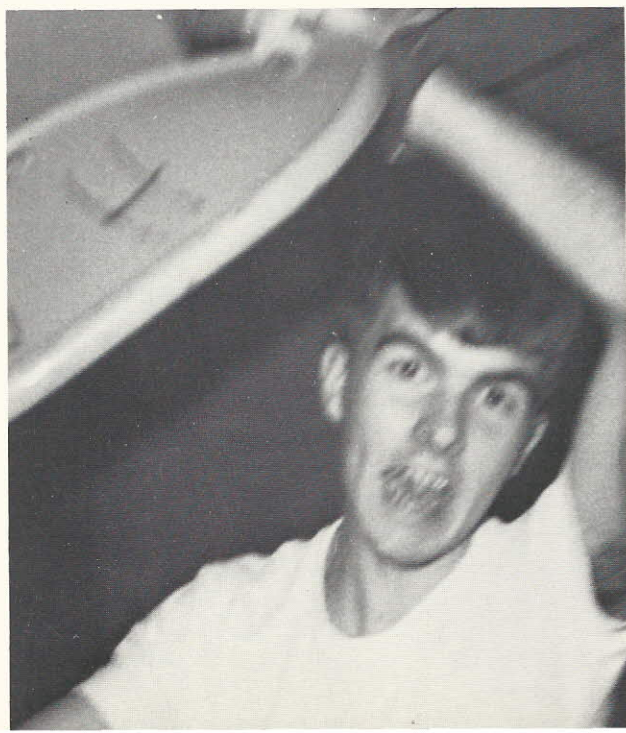


## MAJOR ROY VANDEGRIFT III
