
I. G. Inspection

As a result of previous inspections CMA is designated an *Honor School with Distinction*, the highest honor accorded a military school.














The school awards have been numerous but we would also like to congratulate the many individual accomplishments.


Cadet Bond is the high scorer on our rifle team with a 260.
