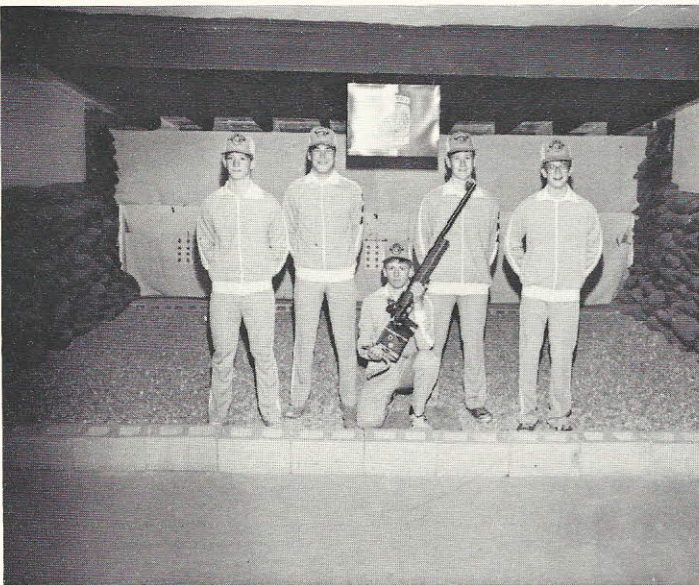
The CMA Rifle Team is rated first in the Third Division of Military Schools, and second in the nation.
