Intramural sports give students who do not play team sports the opportunity to participate in companylevel competitions such as flag-football (right, above right). ### Saturday Morning Inspection

Morning Inspection (SMI) is an experience that cadets one remember after their time at Camden Military Academy.

Though the inspection is not scheduled to begin until nine o'clock morning, cadets often begin preparing days in advance, and hours shining shoes and brass; dusting presses, desks, and window sills; vacuuming floors; cleaning latrines; and beds. The cadet chain of command and the company officer put the finishing touches on their individual moanies.





LTC. Armstrong and the Battalion Staff conduct the individual barracks inspections first, which are followed by an outside battalion in-ranks uniform inspection. The commandant and battalion commander inspect the cadets' uniforms and personal appearance from head to toe, critiquing individual's uniforms and grading each company on their efforts.

The winning company is the one with the highest overall grade following both phases of the SMI. In addition to the all-important bragging rights, the winning company is rewarded with special incentives such as meritorious furloughs and the ever-popular "sleep-ins."

Squadron 805 has been with Camden Military Academy since 2003, when it was formed by cadets with the help of LTC Glenn Melburg, USAF (Ret). From its beginning, Squadron 805 has been playing an important role in building the Camden Military cadets into strong leaders. Since 2003, Camden Military has had three Battalion Adjudents, two Company Commanders, one Battalion Commander, as well as numerous other high leadership positions held by Squadron 805 cadets. Squadron 805 works jointly with other CAP squadrons in South Carolina on ground search and rescue programs, communication classes, leadership classes, and so on. Many Squadron 805 cadets are qualified in Emergency Services Programs, Ground Team Member and Radio Operations. 







#### **Cross Country**


#### **Varsity Bowling**
