Two of the newest initiatives at Camden Military involve all of the Cadets having school e-mail accounts and the technology component of Google Drive, Google Docs, Google Sheets, and Google Slides. In Captain Wright's English and Spanish classes, each cadet was responsible for a Google Slides presentation and a written assignment through Google Docs. Mrs. Boland, the wife of Col. Boland has done some extensive work with her 7th and 8th math students on making blueprints and she used Google Sheets to teach her students how to form budget sheets. Many instructors have students present oral projects, research papers, creative writing and take exams that utilize different ways to gauge comprehension of course material.
