

CHANGING THE GUARD



A highly important and traditional military custom employed at Carlisle is the changing of the guard.

Every duty except night guard extends for a period of twenty-four hours.

Each day at noon, the new guard and retiring guard form to observe a guard mount routine. The officer of the day, a commissioned officer, is in charge of each guard. He is fully responsible for maintaining the good conduct and discipline of cadets at school and on leave through the duties of the officers of the guard, sergeants of the guard, and military police.

The changing of the guard should not be taken for granted, for without guard duty, there would be no controlling element in the school's routine.
