THE HONOR COUNCIL

Discipline at Carlisle is very largely handled by the cadets themselves. When an offense involves a breach of honor, the offender is brought before the Honor Council which is composed of all the cadet captains, presided over by the cadet major with Captain Waddy Thompson, P.M.S.&T., as the faculty advisor.

The Honor Council gathers evidence from all sides and then, serving as a jury, recommends punishment to the Headmaster. Col. Risher makes a final decision and issues the results as proper means of punishment.
