

CHANGING OF THE GUARD

An important phase of military life at Carlisle is the changing of the guard.

Each day at noon, the new and retiring guard form to observe guard mount routine. The officer of the day, a commissioned officer, is in charge of each group. He is responsibile for maintaining discipline of the cadets at school and on leave through the officers and sergeants of the guard, and the Military Police.

This traditional military custom is the keystone of the cadet government. Every commissioned and non-commissioned officer learns to exercise authority with justice and judgment and to command the respect of fellow cadets by soldierly conduct.
