


## FOREWORD


# CROSS SABER CLUB




The Library Club is one of the most active organizations at Carlisle, and helps the cadets to acquaint themselves with the services, resources, and procedures of the library.



This organization is due much credit for its contribution to the social activity at school.





Each year the club has an annual picnic at one of the neighboring parks.








The Block "C" Club is one of the most active and popular organizations on the campus.

The purpose of the club is to provide higher standards of sportsmanship, to develop better leadership, and to try to add as much as possible to the athletic program at Carlisle.


