## PROLOGUE

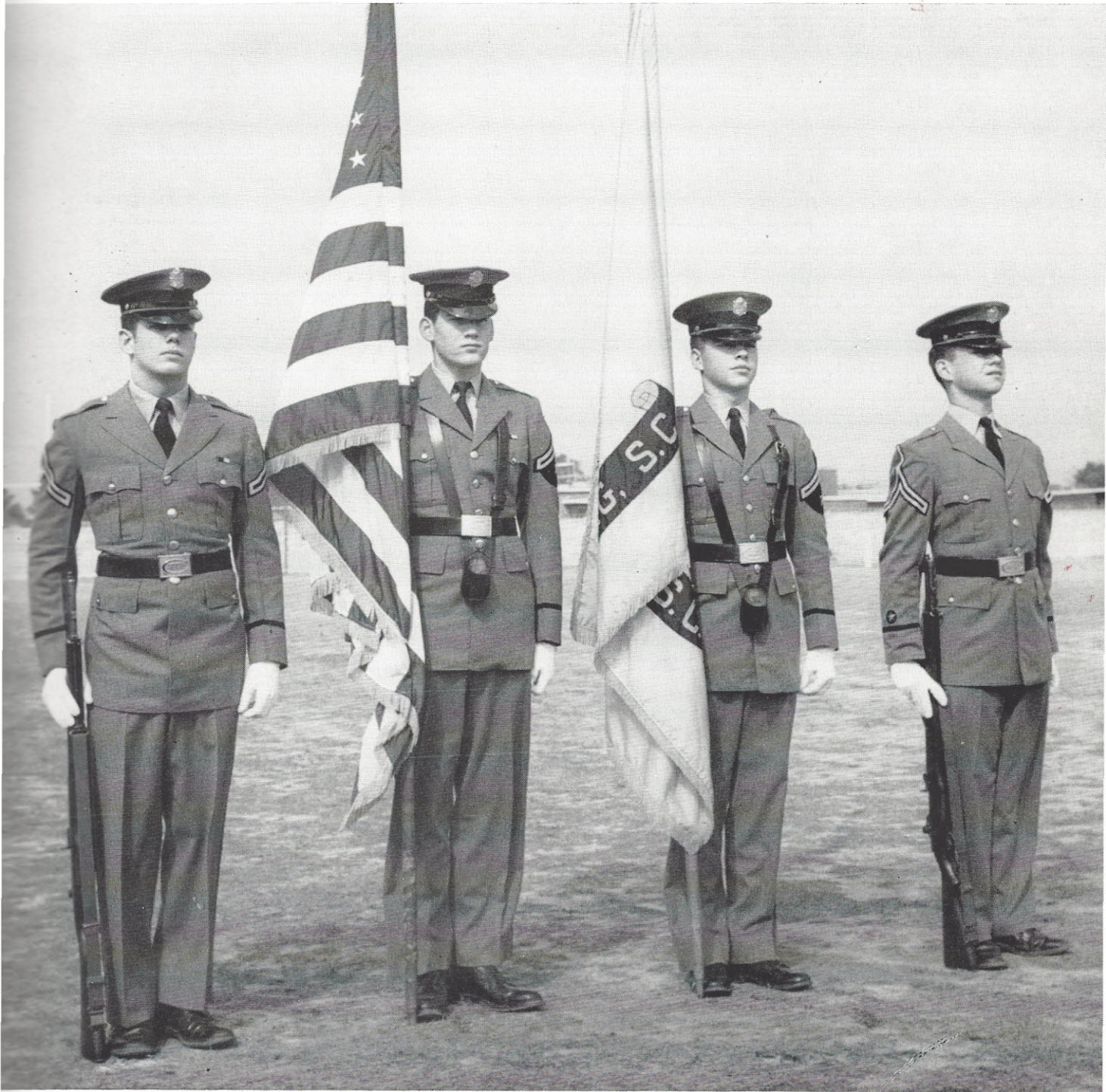

Much credit is due to this organization and to its members who donate their free time to provide cadets with a more enjoyable social life.

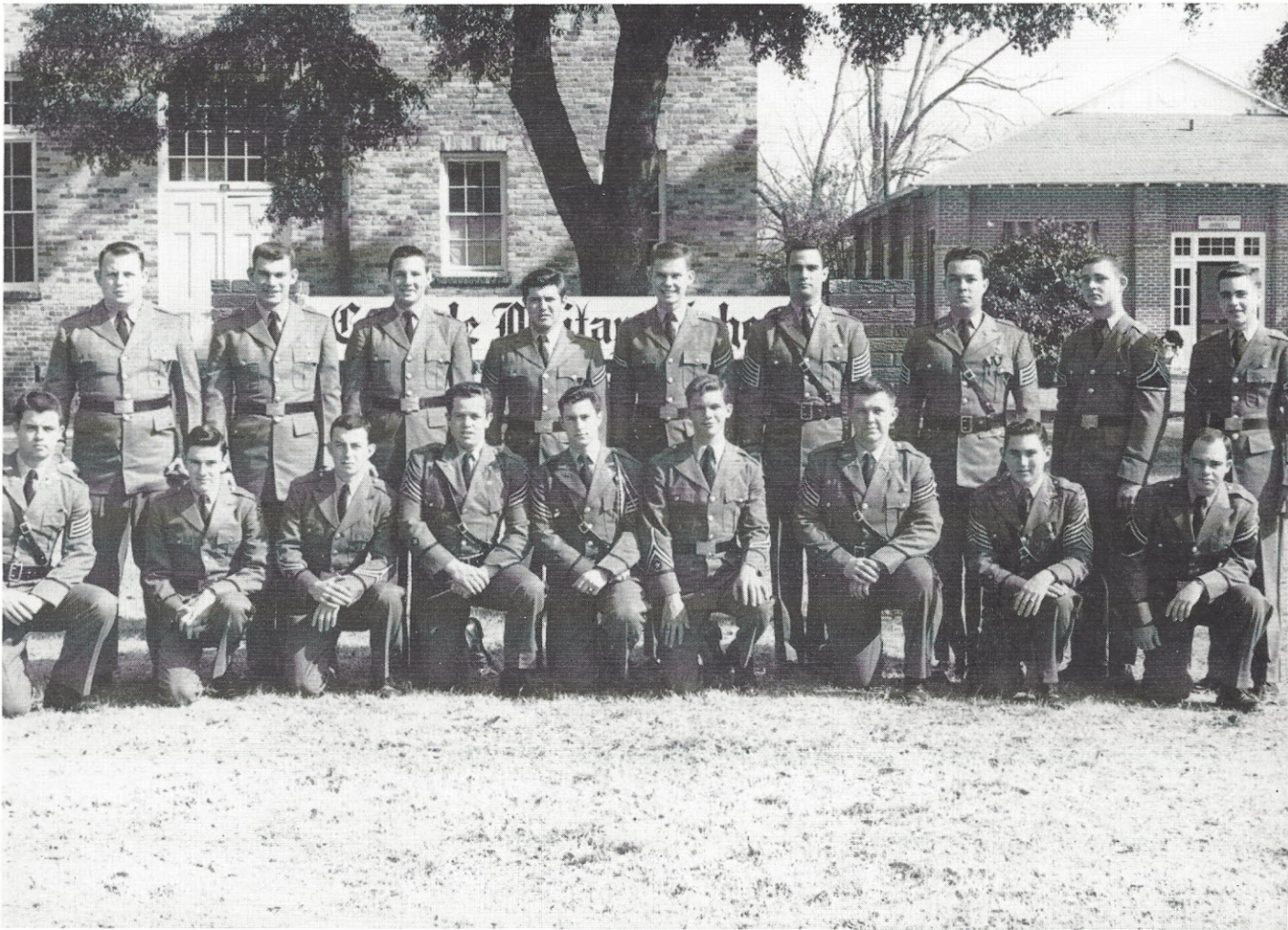

days before the old cadets arrive and ends approximately six weeks later. This year the Cadre was a success, as it has been since it was started four years ago.

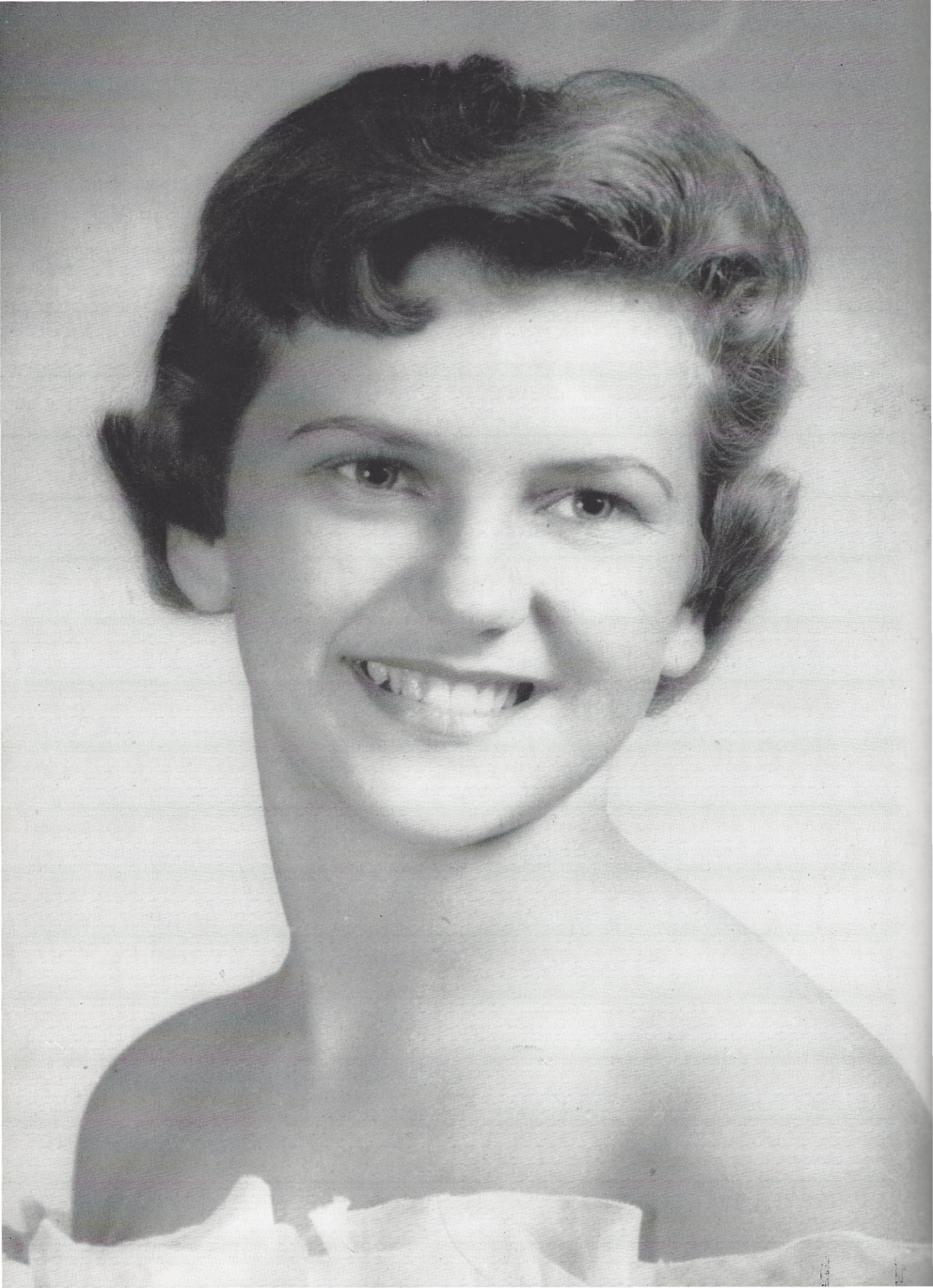

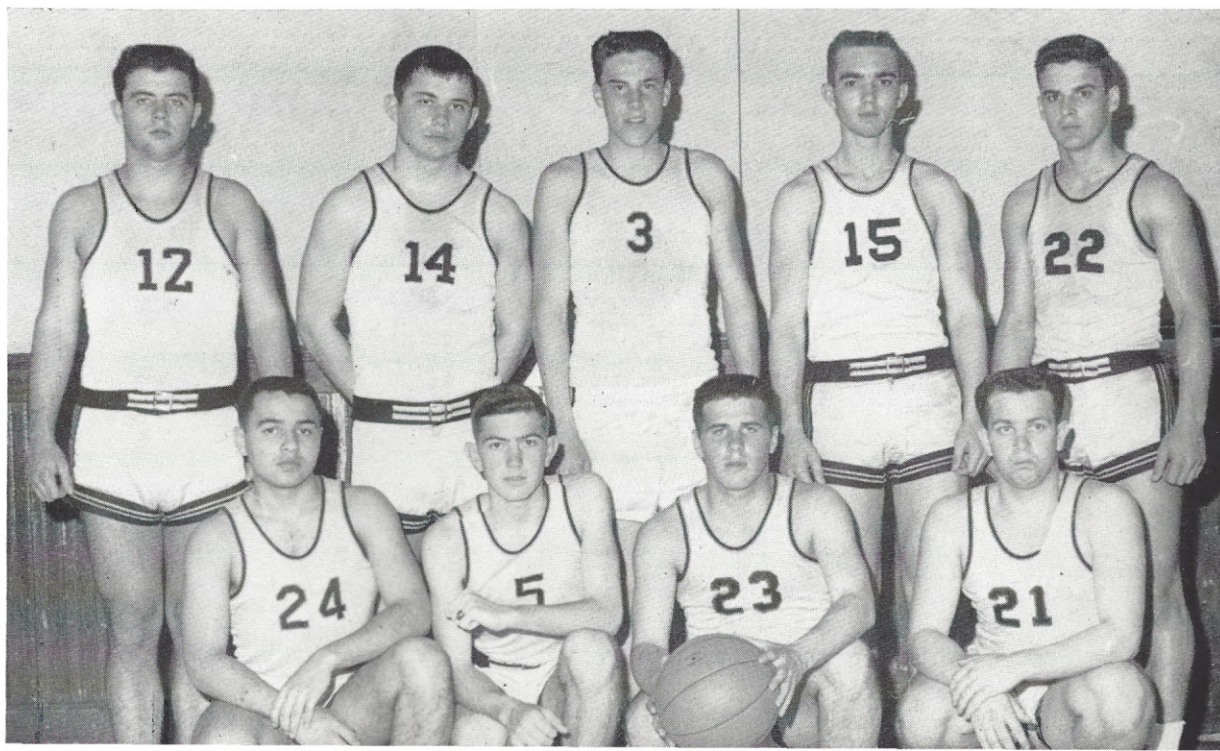
## VARSITY

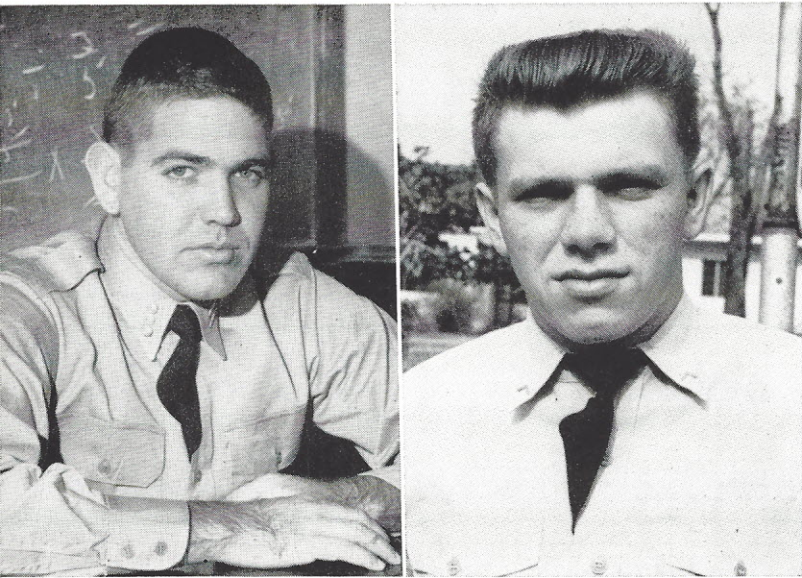
