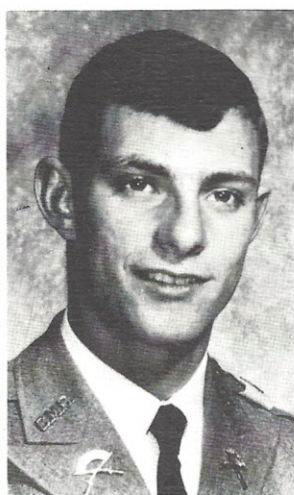
And now we're leaving — again. It seems we're always leaving: something for something else — somewhere for somewhere else.

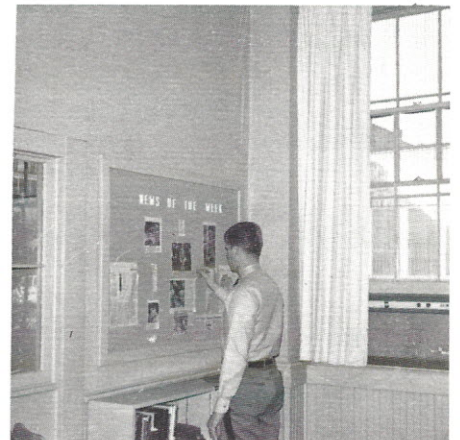
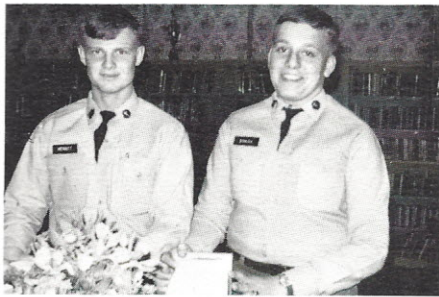


Photo Club
