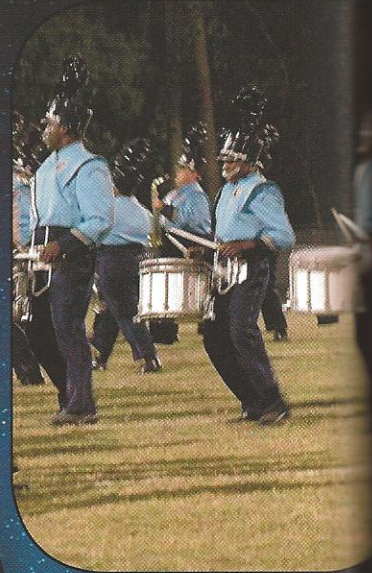


Marching to a Different Drum

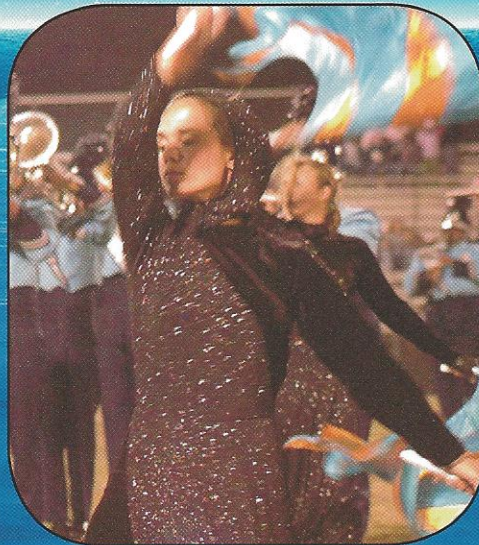

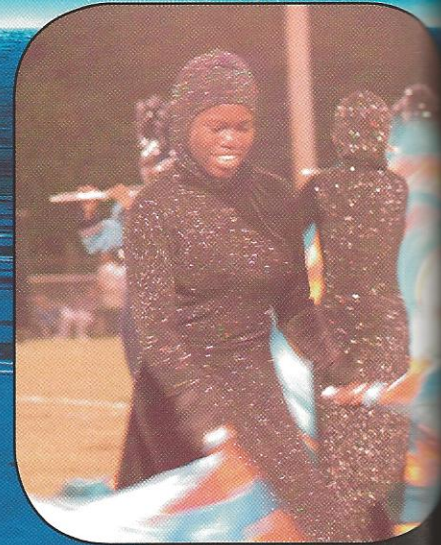

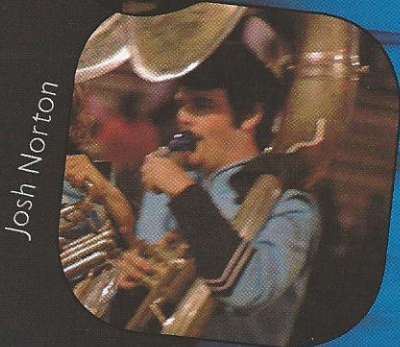
