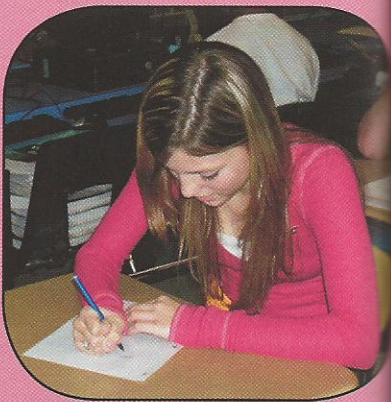
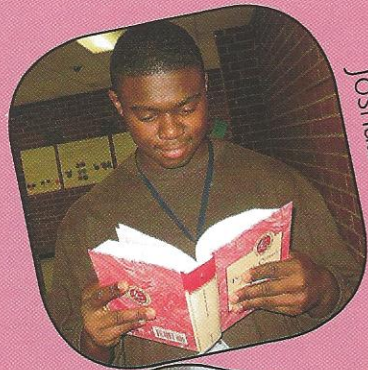


# Broken English

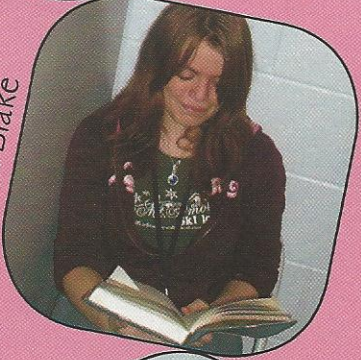


“The thing I like about my English class is the bell ringers. It gets me thinking some times,” freshman Katelin Harriett said.

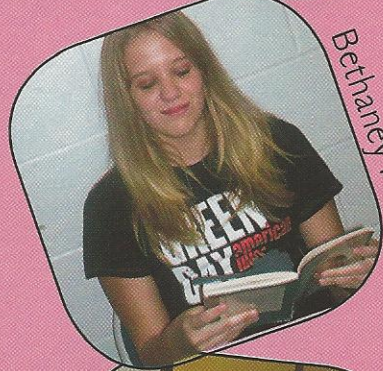

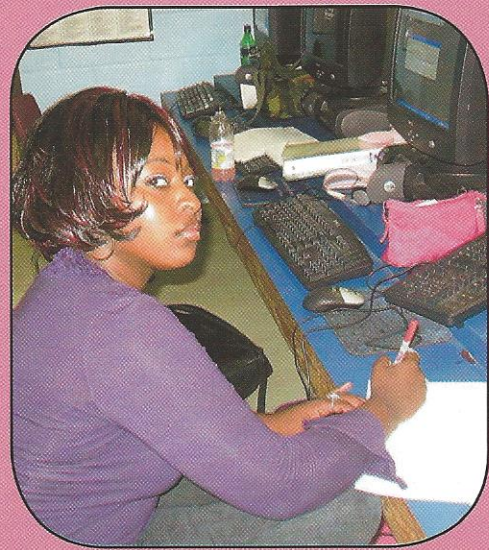

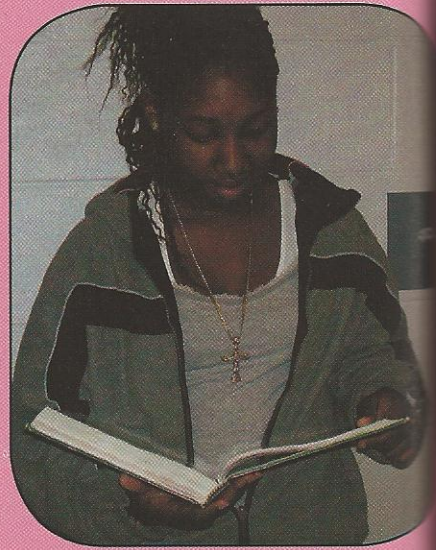
