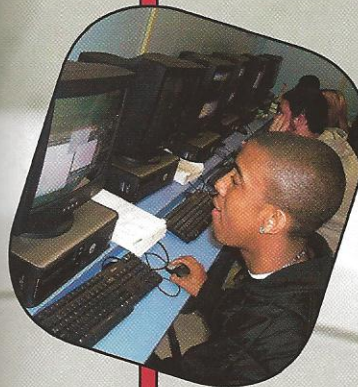


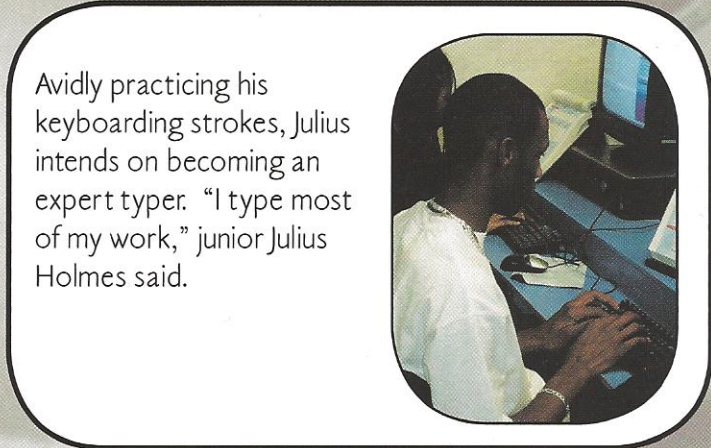
Doing what she does best Megan Musgrave finishes her keyboarding work. "I wouldn't be able to live one day without a computer," junior Megan Musgrave said.



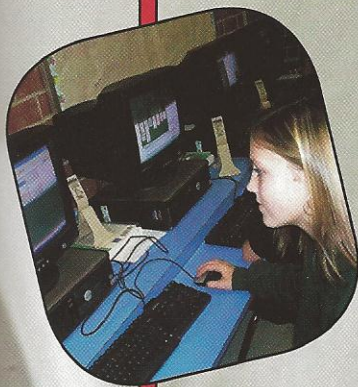
Concentrating on his key strokes junior Ralph Willey carefully completes a keyboarding assignment. "This class helps me complete other class assignments," Ralph said.



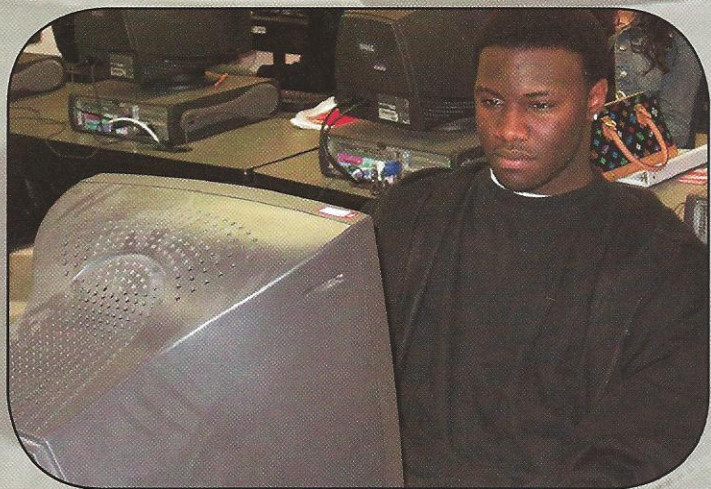
Taking a break from typing Dexter plays a game. "I don't know where I would be without my cellphone," junior Dexter Linder said.



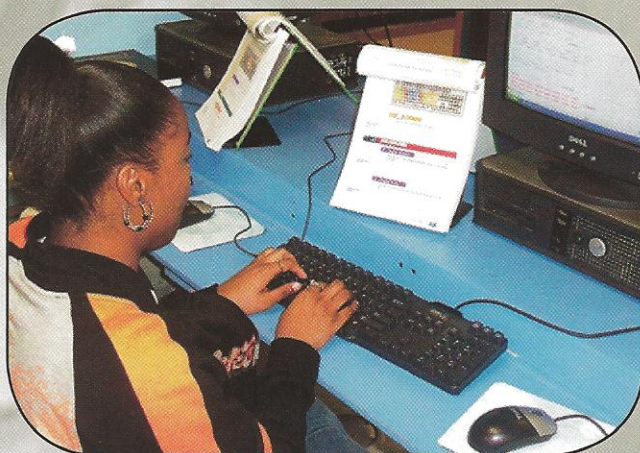
Avidly practicing his keyboarding strokes, Julius intends on becoming an expert typer. "I type most of my work," junior Julius Holmes said.
