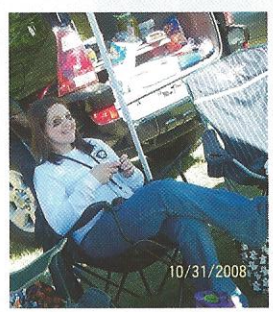




These Spirit Week Pants Belonged To...

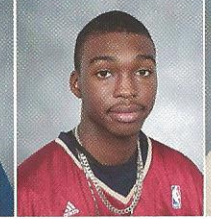
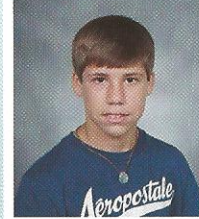
