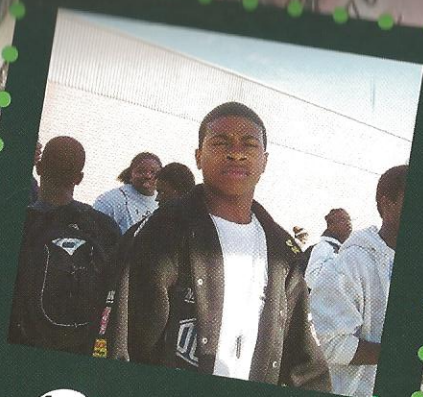
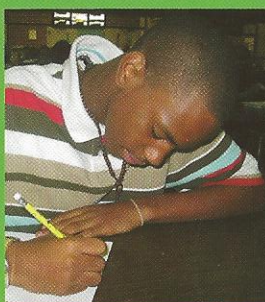
Senior Paige Gilliard drinks the rest of her tea before heading back to class. "I think the best way to always have money is to save it," Paige said.

Junior Domonique Brown sat at the lunch table filling out some applications. "I don't even know why I'm filling these out. My daddy always gives me money," Domonique said.

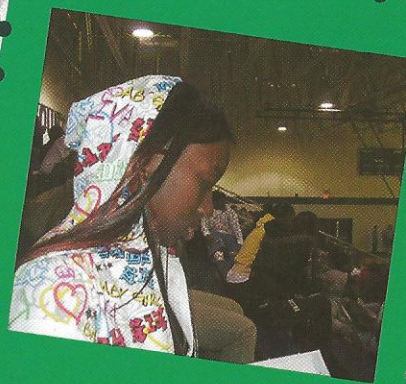
Sophomore Matthew Bennett finishes up his homework during lunch. "If I had a lot of money, I would buy clothes and give them out to the community," Matthew said.
