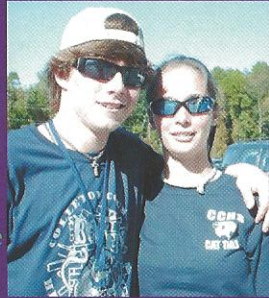

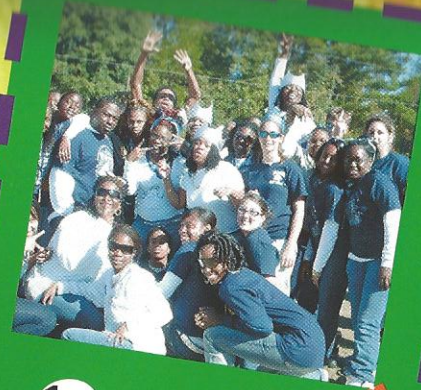
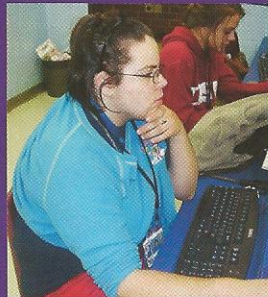
Senior Kawone Winter showed off his feminine side on opposite day. "No I did not like the day they added this year it was wack," Kawone said.

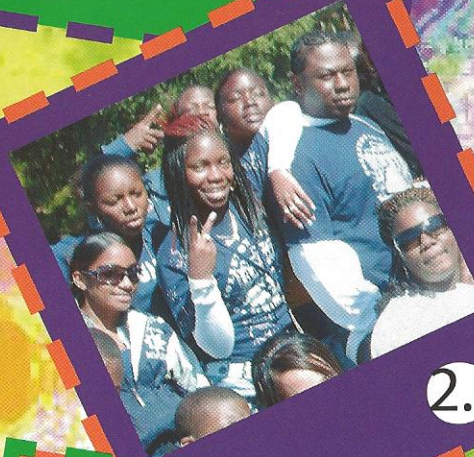
