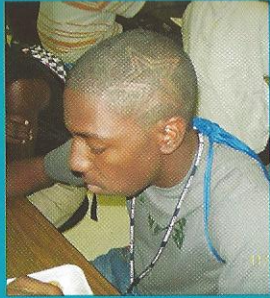
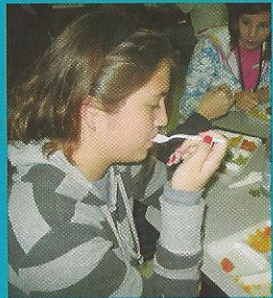

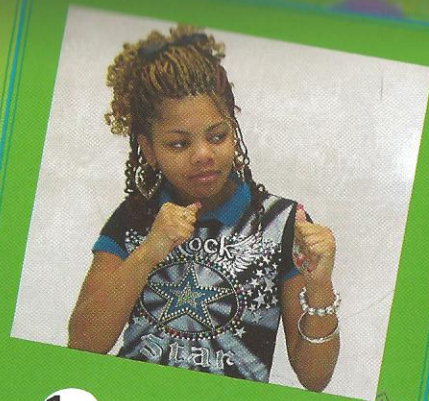
Senior Maurice Hodges sat down to take a break from third period at the lunch table. "I wish I could get paid without working," Maurice said.

Senior Cheyenne Gaddy checked in at the Attendance Office to pick up a tardy slip. "I wish I didn't have to have a job," Cheyenne said.

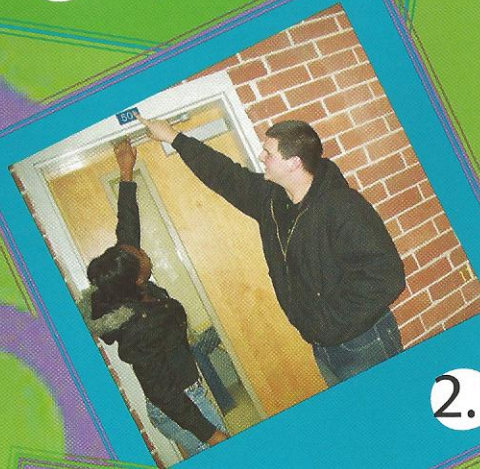


Junior Elizabeth Pangalangan ate with her friends during second lunch. "The money that I make I either put it in the bank or use it for gas," Elizabeth said.

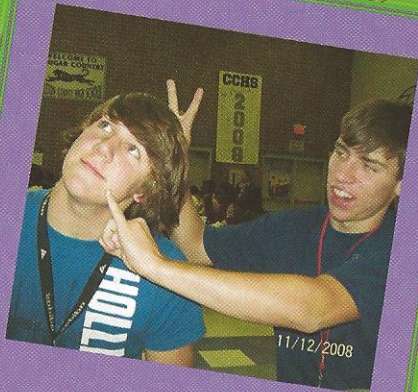
