Freshman India Willaford sat in the library during third period doing research for her creative writing class. "I like being here because I think we get a little more freedom than I did at my last school," India said.

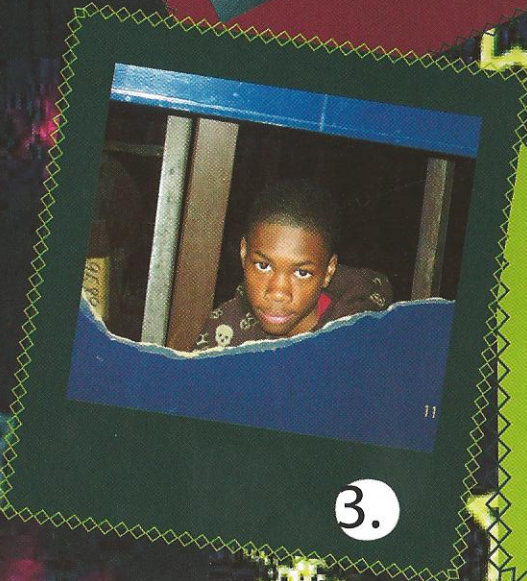
