Richard was standing next to a tree before school one morning. "The reason I joined band is because my sister was in it," senior Richard Linder said.



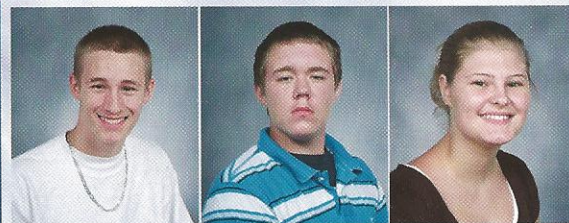
Senior Gary Howell was leading the band at the homecoming game friday night. "I got in band to benefit my leadership skills and build good character traits," Gary said.

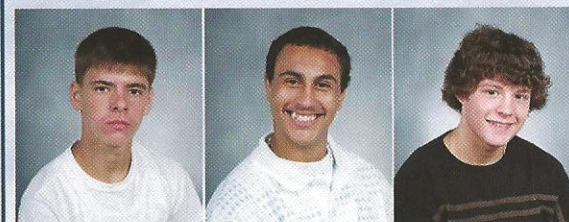
