Senior Christan Spires, during fourth lunch, laughed and talked with friends. "I took newspaper because I wanna go into journalism," Christan said.

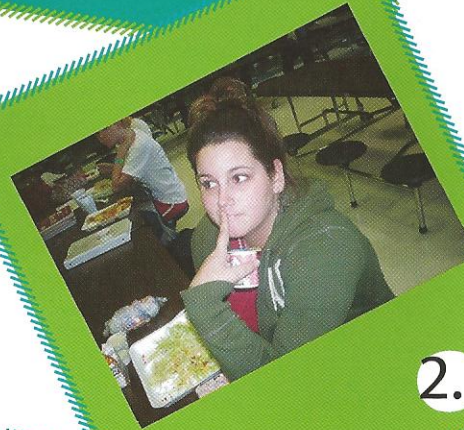


Sophomore Melissa Weber practiced her lines for the upcoming play in Mrs. Gant's room. "Drama Rocks!" Melissa said.

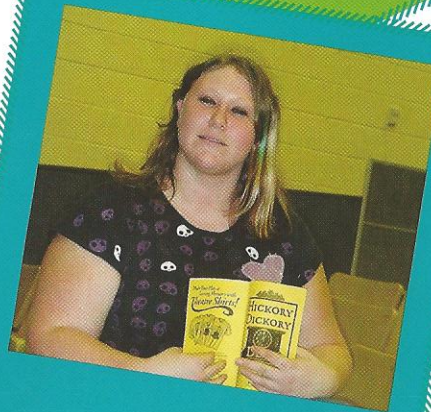
