



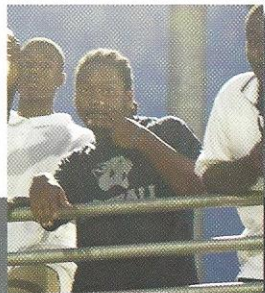
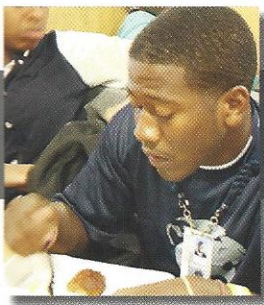
# Catch the Win

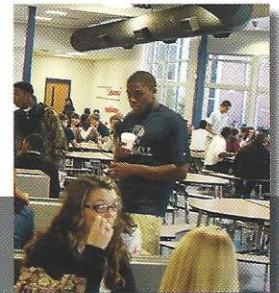
