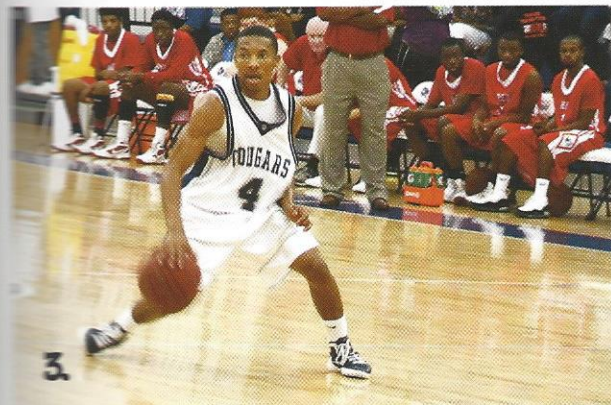


# Pluck the Points

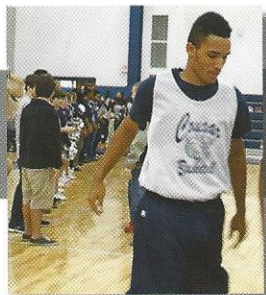


- 1. Junior Jami Sanders, #13, keeps his eye on the ball as he blocks an opponent.
