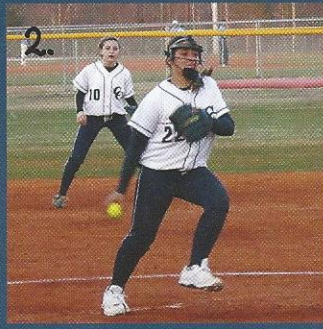


Conquer the Field

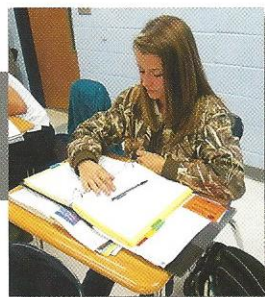


The Lady Cougars huddle around the coach to listen to the game plan for their next round. Sweating down their faces, the Lady Cougars won the first game of the season.
