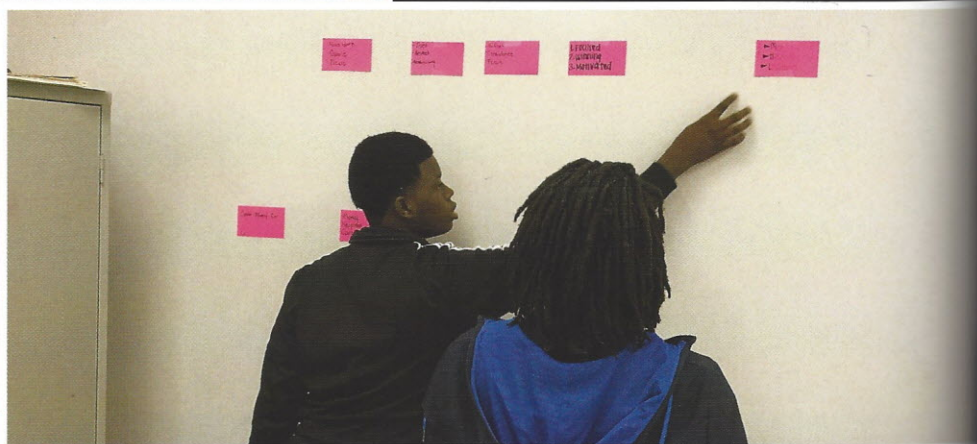


After a thrilling trip to Washington, DC, the JAG members along with Mr. Thomas and SC Rep. Tim Scott head home from Charleston airport.

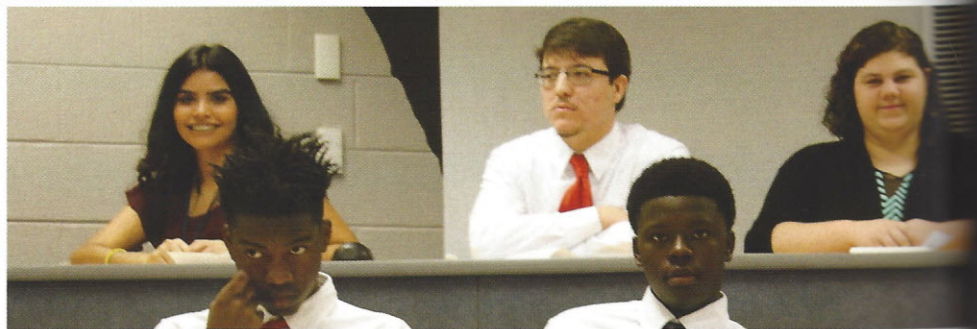
Seniors Shantasia Allen, Jahmari Johnson and Phoenix Brown all stop for a quick moment after being inducted into the JAG program.
