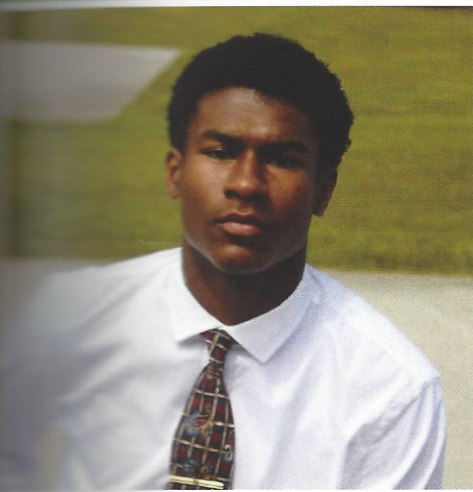


MEN OF DISTINCTION

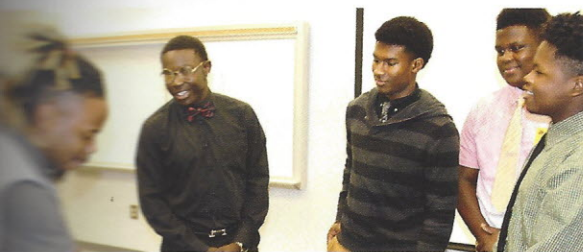
