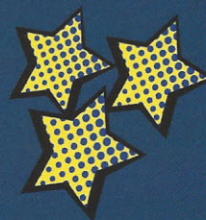

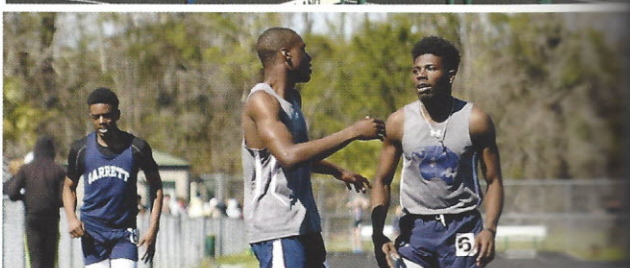


Left: Sophomores Grayson (left) and Abigail (right) run the 1600 meter dash finals as they finish fourth and third respectively.
