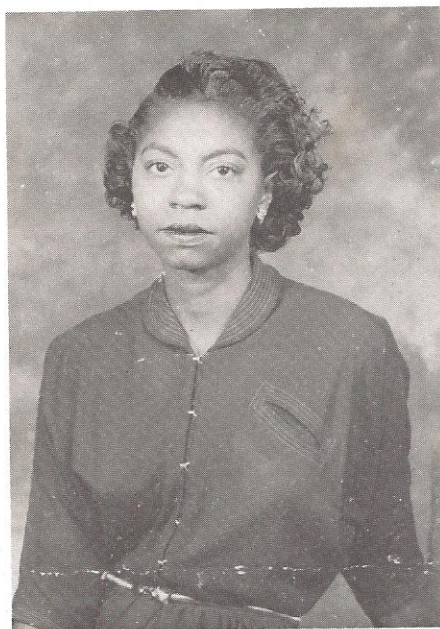

Greetings:

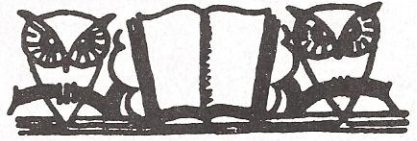
