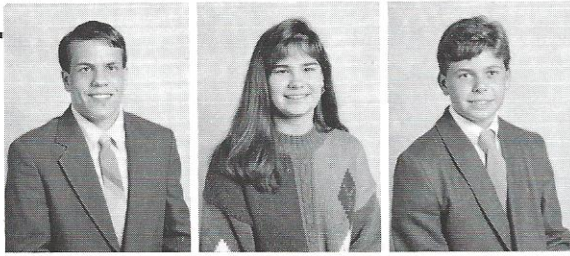


# Sophomores

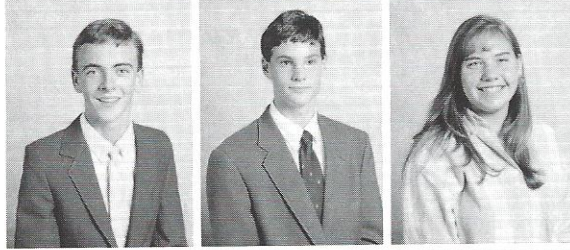
*Individuals and a team —
