

Meeting Future Deadlines

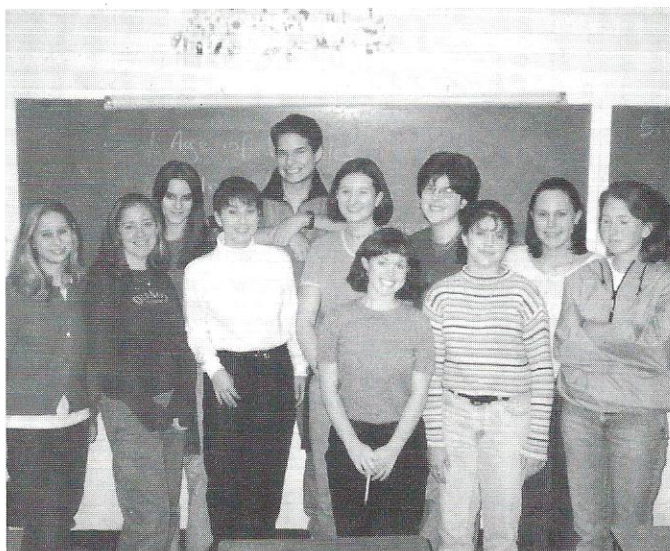

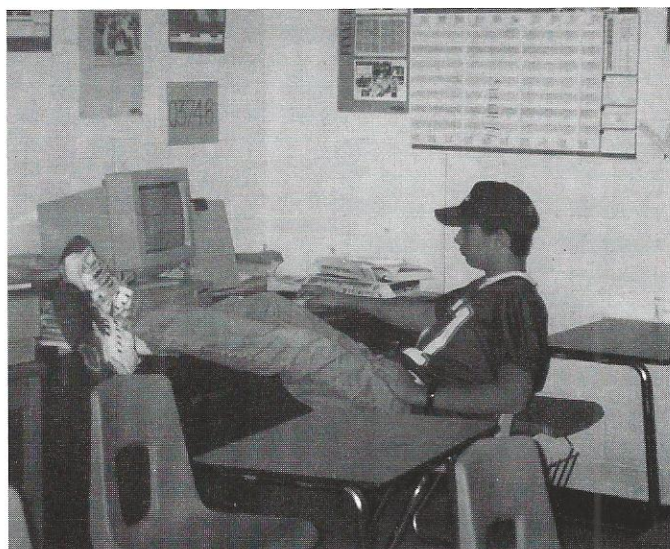
